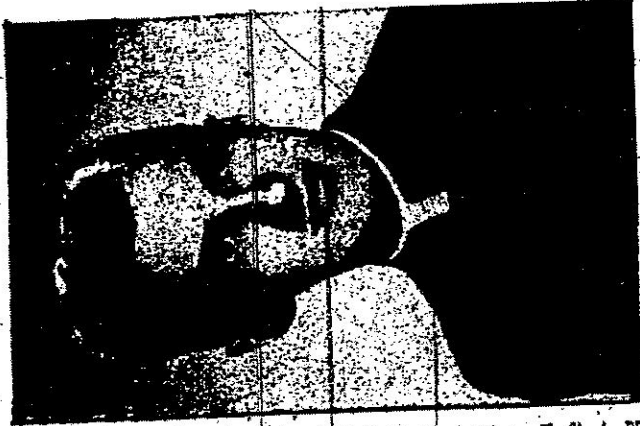




REV. DAVID A. ERNST

Ordination For Local Man

The Rev. David Aloysius Ernst son of Mr. and Mrs. David A. Ernst of 233 Walnut avenue, will be ordained into the priesthood by Archbishop Thomas A. Boland at St. Patrick's Pro-Cathedral Newark, on May 29.
