The Defendant, Warren Jeffs, by and through counsel, hereby move this Court as follows:

1. To permit the Defendant's personal physician, Dr. Lloyd Barlow, to have unfettered, unsupervised, unmonitored and non-eavesdropped physical contact with Mr. Jeffs at the Purgatory Correctional Facility.
2. To obtain a second opinion on the diagnosis and appropriate medical treatment for the Defendant from Dr. Thomas E. Bittker and Dr. Warner, and for Drs. Bittker and Warner to have unfettered, unsupervised, unmonitored and non-eavesdropped contact with Mr. Jeffs at the Purgatory Facility

3. To provide doctors Barlow and Bittker access to the medical records pertaining to the Defendant's recent hospitalization at the Dixie Regional Medical Center, all medical treatment at the Purgatory Correctional facility, including physician and nursing notes, and all medical records prepared by Dr. Stephen B. Seager, a physician employed by the Purgatory Correctional Facility to render medical assistance to the Defendant.

This Motion is based upon the following circumstances:

1. During the Defendant's pretrial incarceration / detention at the Purgatory Correctional Facility, the Defendant has lost approximately 30 pounds.
2. The Defendant has fasted, is dehydrated, and sleep deprived.
3. On today's date the undersigned counsel personally spoke with Dr. Seager who advised that he would welcome a second opinion on the diagnosis and appropriate treatment for Mr. Jeffs. Dr. Seager indicated his willingness to fully consult with any physicians retained by the defense to make a diagnosis and recommend treatment for the Defendant.
4. The State, by and through its counsel, Brock Belnap, has thus far indicated an unwillingness to allow any physicians retained by the defense to consult with the Defendant even for the purpose of diagnosis and evaluating appropriate future medical treatment without the presence of a jail correctional officer, medical and/or nursing staff.
5. The Defendant is being prosecuted by the State of Utah.
6. The Defendant is unlikely to be candid and otherwise share information and communicate with a physician if jail personnel are present.

7. Dr. Barlow is the Defendant's personal physician. They enjoy a comfortable, trusting relationship.


8. Dr. Bittker's curriculum vitae is attached.


