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
Media Intervenors the Associated Press, CNN, *Deseret Morning News*, *The Salt Lake Tribune*, *The Spectrum*, *The Daily Herald*, KSL-TV, KUTV 2 News, the Utah Media Coalition, and the Utah Headliners Chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists (collectively the “Media Intervenors”), through their undersigned counsel, respectfully move the Court to amend paragraph 8 of the Amended Decorum Order.

The basis for this Motion is that the Amended Decorum Order, as currently written, constitutes an unconstitutional prior restraint because it directly regulates what the media may publish, rather than regulating the conduct of the media in the courtroom. The Media Intervenors believe this is an unintended oversight that can be easily corrected in a way that accomplishes the same purpose without violating the First Amendment, and they respectfully request that the Court do so.

This Motion is supporting by a Memorandum of Points and Authorities, submitted concurrently herewith, together with the other pleadings and documents on file herein. Pursuant to Rule 7(e) of the *Utah Rules of Civil Procedure*, the Media Intervenors request a hearing on this Motion, and would be willing to have the Motion heard during the already-scheduled closure hearing on July 17, 2007 at 9:00 a.m.


