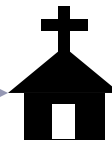

3 meetings with Vicar General

DZ's report to Archdiocese (October 2005)

Katinas Resigns After DZ Investigation and Eventually is Exposed (2006-2007)

- Katinas admits to GOAA Assistant Chancellor he molested others (May 2006)
- Katinas' resigns due to "health reasons" (June 2006)
- GOAA suspends Katinas but does not announce this publicly (July 2006)
- Doe I victim reports abuse to Archdiocese (Sep. 2006)
- Katinas' suspension first published in GOAA's *Orthodox Observer* (Nov. 2006)
- Katinas sexual misconduct officially announced at Holy Trinity, Dallas (Feb. 2007)
- *The National Herald* reports GOAA defrocked Katinas July 11, 2007 (Sep. 2007)
