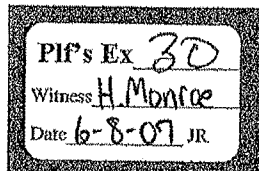
I am enclosing a map to assist you should you decide to drive to Montara. Having your own car would be to your advantage since public transportation in Montara is at a minimum. There is ample parking space for automobiles.

In the event that you choose to go by plane, we ask you to reserve your flight to arrive at the SAN FRANCISCO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. We would ask that you arrive before 3:00 PM on June 17.

Once you have finalized your travel, please so inform Father Bush, Director at Montara, of your plans, airlines, flight number, time of arrival, etc. He would then arrange to have a staff member meet your airport arrival, should this be needed.

You will have a private room so feel free to bring a radio if you so wish. TV sets for individual use are not permitted. You will need your own cassette type tape recorder to listen to lectures, etc.

Bring comfortable clothes. Your clerical attire may be needed for special liturgical celebrations and ministry.

All towels and linens are provided by the House. Your personal laundry will be taken care of on a weekly basis.

Clothes to bring as to what type of weather, swimming, etc., could best be questioned when you call Montara to confirm your arrival.

While in residency it will be necessary for you to receive a monthly stipend to enable you to join other residents for occasional dining-out, movies, concerts, etc., which we consider most therapeutic and strongly encourage.

Father Monroe, please feel free to call here or at Montara for any question you may need to be answered prior to your arrival on June 17th.
