Offense / Incident Narrative

On July 22, 2009 at approx. 5:50 p.m. while on patrol I was dispatched to Noah's Ark Water Park for a suspicious activity complaint.

Upon my arrival, I met near the main entrance with Noah's Ark Manager Robert Herum and employee Justin Strayer. They informed me that the male subject sitting in the picnic area, later identified by me as Patrick A. Umberger m/w d.o.b. 10/21/50, had been up near the kiddie pool restrooms for over an hour. They said that a family was in the kiddie pool watching him, and reported that he sat on the bench in front of the mens' restrooms. They watched, and as little boys entered the restroom, Patrick would follow the boys inside. They noticed that he did this repeatedly, so they contacted Noah's Ark employees. Employees Justin and Robert told me that after they received the report, they watched two young boys enter the restroom. They observed Patrick get up from the bench and follow the boys into the restroom. Justin said that when they entered the restroom behind him, he was at the urinal, however he said that he was not certain that he was actually using it or just standing there.

Justin said that based on the initial report and their observations they made contact with Patrick and then called the police. Justin said that the subject reported to them that he was there with his sister. Justin said that they paged her several times and tried to call her with no success. Justin said that when they told him they were unable to contact his sister, he said that she had probably already left.

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I met with and verbally identified Patrick. Patrick shook my hand and provided me with the information I requested. He told me that he is a Catholic priest, and he has a season park pass to Noah's Ark. He said that he comes here frequently with different people all of the time. Patrick claimed to be with his sister and her husband today. He told me that he had driven from Onalaska to Lake Delton, which he claims to be approx. 1 1/2 hour drive. Patrick said that they drove in separate vehicles. He said that he had gotten to the park at approx. 3:45 p.m., and was planning to leave just before he was contacted by the employees. Patrick said that he was not staying in the area, and he was planning to drive the 1 1/2 hours back to Onalaska. Patrick was wearing swimming trunks that were completely dry and a t-shirt that was also dry. He did not appear to have gotten wet at all. He told me that he was near the restrooms because he has prostate problems and has to urinate frequently. He went over his health history with me, claiming to have been hospitalized recently and in a coma. He said that he had more testing in the near future with his prostate.

I asked Patrick how long he had been near the restrooms. He told me that he was there for approx. 5-10 minutes. I asked Patrick why he was at Noah's Ark, with his numerous health problems. Patrick said that he just likes to get away. I asked him about who he had come with. He said his sister. I asked if he had been with her at all that day. He told me he had, and he was supposed to meet her at 5:30 p.m. near the picnic area where he was.

I left Patrick to check his information and contact Onalaska Police Department. I called their police department to see if they had any information for him. The dispatcher that I spoke with told me that the only contact they had with him was for a speeding ticket. They did confirm that his address was the same address as St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Onalaska.

I then returned to talk with Patrick. I again asked him to tell me about his day. This time he told me that his sister had probably left, as she had to be to work by 5:30 p.m.

After I was done talking with Patrick, I asked him for permission to take his picture, he agreed. I took several photos of Patrick, both standing and sitting. I then informed Patrick that Noah's Ark Water Park was revoking his season pass, and did not want him on their property again. I told Patrick that he was free to go, and instructed him to leave the property. I did offer to give him a ride to his vehicle, which he accepted. Patrick was parked in the handicap parking area, in front of the upper ticket booth, near the "kiddie pool". When we got to Patrick's vehicle, I again told him that he was free to leave. I then asked Patrick if the vehicle that he was driving was registered to him, he said that it was. I asked Patrick for permission to search his vehicle, and he gave me consent to do so. Patrick opened the passenger door for me. In looking in his vehicle, I observed a box of Kleenex on his front passenger seat, as well as several used tissues sitting on the passenger seat. I also observed a tissue box under both the driver and passenger seats. Patrick had a pair of jeans and underwear sitting on the front passenger side floor. I also observed a duffel bag in the rear hatchback area. There was a change of clothes in the bag, as well as a shaving kit with his toiletries. Also see the vehicle information.

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After searching Patrick's vehicle, I thanked him, and again told him he was free to leave.

I then had Justin escort me to the mens' restroom where Patrick had been sitting. Justin showed me what bench that he had been sitting on. In looking at the area of the water park where Patrick was, there are no adult activities in this area. All of the activities are for small children. I completed a search of the mens' restroom for any possible evidence or contraband that Patrick may have left behind, not locating any
