Twin Immaculate Conception Parish, Port Clinton with Saint Joseph Parish, Marblehead.

Sacred Heart Parish, Toledo, St. Stephen Parish, Toledo, and St. Thomas Aquinas Parish, Toledo to develop a plan for the three parishes consisting of a single pastoral team with one pastor for the three parishes. Good Shepherd Parish, Toledo becomes an integrated, bi-lingual community.
