

SALESIAN SHAME FILE



FR MICHAEL AUSLEBROOK

Was boarding master at Rupertswood in the early 1990s and later stood down as principal at the Salesians' St Mark's College in South Australia when allegations were levelled against him in 2004. Was sentenced to a total of two years' jail with 15 months wholly suspended in 2011 after pleading guilty to assaulting a 12-year-old victim five times.

Payout: Undisclosed



FR JULIAN FOX

Former college principal accused of abusing students during the 1970s and '80s. Moved to Fiji in 1999 just before allegations against him were made public. Banned from contact with children by the Salesians and now works for the order's head office in Rome, 10km from the Vatican.

Payouts: At least \$36,000



FR JOHN "JACK" AYERS

Accused of abusing students during the 1960s and '70s. Moved to Samoa in 1998 with colleague and convicted paedophile Fr Frank Klep. Banned from contact with children by the Salesians and now resides in a Samoan nursing home.

Payouts: At least \$45,000



BR GREGORY VINCENT COFFEY (DEC)

Accused of physical and sexual abuse while teaching at Rupertswood. Was moved between Salesian parishes interstate before he left the order. Pled guilty to six counts of indecent assault against two students in 1976-77 at Immaculate Heart Marist Brothers College, Preston. Sentenced to 2½ years jail, wholly suspended.

Payout: Undisclosed



FR FRANK KLEP

Former college principal who pleaded guilty to 14 charges of indecent assault on 11 boys aged 12 to 17 in the 1970s. Sentenced to a one-year minimum jail term in 2005. Convicted in 1994 of indecent assaults on two other students. Moved with Fr Jack Ayers to Samoa in 1998 – the year police charged him with indecently assaulting a student, 15.

Payout: Up to \$100,000



FR DAVID RAPSON

Former vice principal accused of abusing a teen at a Tasmanian Salesian college between 1983 and 1984. Left Tasmania for a teaching job at Rupertswood about 1986 and was later sentenced to two years' jail for sex offences against boys at the Sunbury college.

Payout: At least \$80,000



BR PETER PAUL VAN RUTH

Convicted of abusing students just weeks into his appointment as a dormitory master and teacher at Sunbury's college in the late 1960s. Left the Salesians after a short period but returned to the Catholic education system in 1978 and became a principal. He lost his job in 2006, when the abuse was revealed. Jailed for two years and four months in February 2011.

Payout: At least \$15,000
