 offending priest will be removed permanently from ecclesiastical ministry,
 not excluding dismissal from the clerical state, if the case so warrants.
- If for reasons such as advanced age or infirmity the penalty of dismissal from the clerical state is not applied for an established act of sexual abuse of a minor, the offending priest will lead a life of prayer and penance and the restrictions from any priestly ministry will become permanent.






