

BISHOP ANNOUNCES PASTORAL CHANGES

Father Baumgarten of Holy Trinity Church Transferred to Buffalo.

Changes among the locations of a number of Catholic clergy in the diocese have been announced by Bishop John A. Duffy of Buffalo.

Only two changes affect Dunkirk churches. The Rev. Francis X. Baumgarten, who has been assistant pastor at Holy Trinity church, has been assigned to St. Boniface church, Buffalo. The Rev. Basil A. Ormsby, who has been at St. Ann's chapel in Sinclairville, is transferred to Holy Trinity church.

Others in this vicinity are: the Rev. Thomas J. Dunn, who has been pastor of St. Patrick's church at Brocton, goes to St. Frances de Sales church in Buffalo, while the Rev. Felix O'Neil of St. Ambrose church, Buffalo, becomes pastor at Brocton; the Rev. Joseph P. Walcewski of Cassadaga will go to St. Paul's Kenmore.

Newly-ordained priests have been assigned to the Missionary Apostolate, in charge of several chapels in Chautauqua county. Priests who have been in charge of these chapels and have received new assignments are: the Rev. Emil C. Bogumil of Cherry Creek to Cheektowaga; the Rev. James M. Daley of Sherman to St. Ambrose church, Buffalo, the Rev. Francis S. McCormick of Mayville to St. Paul's, Kenmore, the Rev. Bernard D. Sexton of Kennedy to Holy Cross, Buffalo, the Rev. Paul M. Valente of Ripley to Holy Cross, Buffalo.
