Schmeer on 5-25-04.</p>	<p>- On 5-7-04, a second investigation into more recent allegations was commenced by the Archdiocese. - On 11-2-04, Rev. Schmeer was informed that the Archdiocese found the allegations credible, imposed restrictions on his priestly ministry and referred the case to the Vatican for review of laicization. - On 12-1-04, Rev. Schmeer agreed to the removal of his priestly faculties, to forgo the Church penal process and to accept the imposition of a supervised life of prayer and penance.</p>
