JOINT MOTION TO CONTINUE TRIAL DATE

At this point, even if the settlement discussions were not continuing, we believe that the April 11 trial date would not allow sufficient time for the parties to complete fact discovery, disclose experts and depose each others' experts, exchange witness and exhibit lists, file and brief pretrial motions, submit proposed jury instructions, and complete the many other tasks that would be necessary before trial.

WHEREFORE, the parties respectfully request that the Court continue the trial date for a reasonable time period, to be determined at the March 3, 2005 pretrial hearing.
