This date spoke with:

[REDACTED] advised that he attended Camp Don Bosco in Barrington, NH for four years from the age of 8 to 12. The Selesian Brothers ran the camp and a number of the campers' came from Don Bosco High School and Dominic Savio High School in E. Boston, MA. [REDACTED] advised that he grew up in Winthrop, MA.

[REDACTED] advised that age 12 in 1982 he attended Camp Don Bosco. This was the last year that the camp existed. He described the camps as barracks where the campers slept in bunk beds and the Councilor had a semi private walled off area to himself. He also explained that the camp was for those ages 8 to 12 years of age and in the afternoon there was activity and then a one hour rest period for the younger campers. The older campers (12 yoa) could stay up and play cards or whatever. [REDACTED] explained that he knew how to play cribbage and the Councilor at the time Brother John VOGLIO a Selesian Brother also played cribbage. VOGLIO invited [REDACTED] into the walled off area and they would play cribbage. The first day everything was fine, the second day VOGLIO exposed himself then touched [REDACTED] and this lead to fondling each other and finally oral sex on each other. [REDACTED] advised that the camp was for two weeks. The fondling and oral sex went on beginning within a few days of arriving and continued to the end of the two weeks.

[REDACTED] advised that he has not seen VOGLIO again but did receive a Xmas card from him the Xmas of 1982 postmarked Ohio. That tells him that VOGLIO had his home address. VOGLIO spoke about going on to become a priest with the Selesian's.

[REDACTED] advised that he has gone on the Internet and found a John VOGLIO as a Pastoral Vicar assigned in Bronx, NY. He could not tell if the VOGLIO was with the Selesian's or not.

[REDACTED] advised that he had told his wife about these acts but no one else until 3/27/02 when he told his mother. He advised that he is not coming forward for money or anything else but merely because he has watched the Boston papers and never saw the name of VOGLIO mentioned and felt the truth needed to be known.
