Re: Telephone call from [redacted], Howell, 23 yrs. old.
September 2, 1992 - 11:00 A.M.

[redacted] gave a description of an incident which occurred when he was 14 or 15, working in Sacred Heart Rectory, Howell.

The priest, Raymond Prybis, OMI, asked [redacted] to help him bring cartoons into the lower church around 9 p.m. He left the room for a moment, came back undressed, asked [redacted] to beat him with a belt, while he lay face down on a table. [redacted] did this once, fled, told his parents immediately.

Subsequent meeting of [redacted] father, the pastor, and the priest. The pastor indicated that R.P. would be sent for therapy and that he would follow up with a report to the [redacted].

Current concerns of the caller were provoked by knowing that this priest is "next door" and seeing the film Twin Peaks: Where has he been the last eight years?
(Affecting whom?)

Why did they never receive any report?

CEM: I referred [redacted] to George Kirwin, Provincial through Father P. J. Hollywood at the Oblate Mission House and Residence (same residence as F. Prybis) - to help resolve feeling that things were "sort of dealt with but a little covered up".
