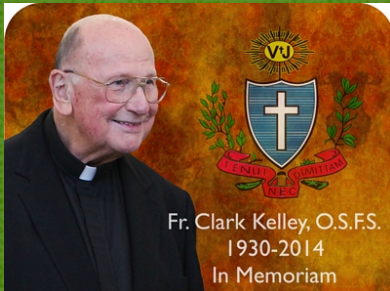

Nov. 6, 1937 - Apr. 7, 2015

Bro. Neil McMenamin, O.S.F.S. passed away peacefully on April 7, 2015 at Anney Hall in Childs, MD. He was born to Neil and Catherine (Meehan) McMenamin in Philadelphia, PA on November 6, 1937 and graduated from Northeast Catholic High School - Philadelphia in 1955. He joined the Oblates of St. Francis de Sales on January 25, 1958.

In 1959, Bro. Neil was assigned to Northeast Catholic High School. In 1962 he was transferred to Salt Lake City, UT to serve the Oblate Community at Judge Memorial High School. He moved further west in 1971 to minister at St. Mary's High School - Stockton, CA, assisting the principal and office staff and caring for his Oblate confreres. From 2010 until his passing Bro. Neil lived in the Oblate retirement community - Childs, MD.

Bro. Neil is remembered for his hard work, much of it done behind-the-scenes, both in Catholic schools and in Oblate communities. He had a strong commitment to high school drama and art programs and was fully engaged in school plays, helping with sound, lighting, sets and costumes.

He is survived by his brother and sister-in-law Edward and Jeanne McMenamin, and six nephews and nieces.

There will be a Mass for Brother Neil Thursday, April 23 at the 7:00 a.m. Mass in the chapel. All are welcome to attend.
