She suspects homo sexual activity takes place at that residence. She has observed cases of beer being brought into the house on several occasions. This woman also stated that her neighbors are aware of what is going on but are afraid to get involved.




THEY TOLD THOMAS THAT THEY HAVE OBSERVED ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS, YOUNG MALES WITH "RECORDS" GOING IN AND OUT OF [REDACTED] HOUSE. ONE OF THE MALES IS [REDACTED] GINGRAS' SAID THAT THESE MALES ARE ABOUT 17 OR 18 Y.O.A. THEY GO TO [REDACTED] RES. TO [REDACTED] WHICH HE HAS SET UP IN HIS HOUSE. GINGRAS' ALSO SUSPECT HOMOSEXUAL ACTIVITY BECAUSE THE ONLY PERSONS WHO EVER SHOW UP AT [REDACTED] HOUSE ARE MALES.

DURING THE PAST FEW MONTHS THE ACTIVITY AT [REDACTED] HOUSE HAS PICKED UP SUBSTANTIALLY. IT IS A FREQUENT PLACE FOR CARS TO BE LINKED UP ON BOTH SIDES OF THE ROAD ON COLES ROAD RD. WITH THE OCCUPANTS ALL AT [REDACTED] MOST OF THE PARTIES AT [REDACTED] HOUSE OCCUR AT NIGHT AND ARE USUALLY IN FULL SWING BY 10:30-11:00 P.M. THEY ARE BIGGER ON THE WEEK-ENDS & HOLIDAYS THAN THEY ARE DURING THE WEEK. ALL PARTIES CONSIST OF "KIDS". GINGRAS' FEAR THAT THE GROUP ATTRACTED TO [REDACTED] HOUSE WILL BECOME SIMILAR TO THE [REDACTED] GROUP THAT CAUSED SO MANY PROBLEMS ON THE CORNER OF [REDACTED] WHICH WAS RUN BY [REDACTED]

GINGRAS STATED THAT THEY HAVE NOTED ON MANY DIFFERENT OCCASIONS A CATHOLIC PRIEST KNOWN AS "FATHER RODGER" SHOWING UP AT [REDACTED] HOUSE.




