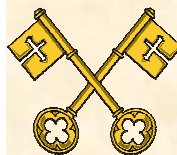

Reflections on Scripture—Jack Conroy, Ph.D.

I. Isaiah 55:1-11. Prophecy of Success

Reflection: First issue for verses 1-7 is, "Who is speaking?" Answer: Lady Wisdom, who appears in the Book of Proverbs; it was she who was present with God at creation, and who offered true food and true drink. It is Wisdom that gives real "Life." And the message of Wisdom is to seek the Lord, and to turn to the Lord. This was probably written in Babylon during the Exile; and the destruction of Jerusalem in 587 was seen as the result first of Israel's sin, as Divine Punishment. This is why "forgiveness" is needed. Second issue for verses 8-11 is, "Now who is speaking?" Answer: The Lord. His ways and thoughts are as different as the Infinite is different from the finite. But the message is positive; God's Word is productive of life, giving vitality to the world. God's word (and we may say, "God's Word." Christ) will achieve the end for which it was sent.

Father G.:

Our Caseworkers conducted more than 2400 cases representing more than 3700 people and families. We provided Spiritual Guidance and support; Bags of Food; Clothing and Work Boots; Furniture; Travel Assistance; Job Referrals; Referrals to Other Agencies and other support.

Volunteers that work in our Food Pantry

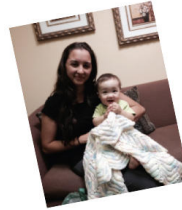
Volunteers that collect food and contributions at St Peter's Church entrance on the second weekend of each month

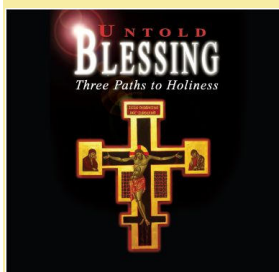

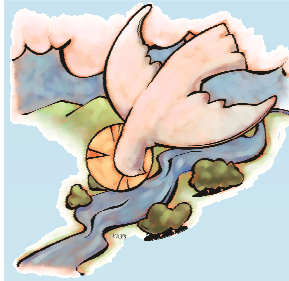
