



 In 1891 Pope Leo XIII wrote *Rerum Novarum* an encyclical about the abuses of the early industrialization of the world decrying, unsafe working condition, long working hours and the workers right to form unions. For over 100 years, many Catholics living in the South embraced the "Jim Crow laws" of segregation.
