I was molestation three times. Not until recently was I aware that he went after all the boys. But did not limit himself to us.

Even now I can not even sit through a mass without seeing so much dishonesty in the Catholic church. Or when I turn on the television and see Father Rays face telling people how to live. What about all those children? I was only one of so many.
