[REDACTED] - victim of Fr. James Foley - meeting took place on March 28, 2001 from 3:45 - 4:30 PM.

This discussion occurred for two reasons:

1. to inform [REDACTED] we have responded to his accusation in an active way.
2. once again ask about the truthfulness of this accusation because Fr. Foley continues to maintain his innocence.

[REDACTED] was appreciative of the Archdiocese response and reiterated that he has told the truth concerning Fr. Foley, and wishes that he could remember more details concerning his abuse. Informed him of Fr. Foley's recent journey since the accusation. [REDACTED] is satisfied that Fr. Foley is no posing any threat to children and that he has no ministry that involves minors. I communicated Fr. Foley's long standing denial - [REDACTED] responded "I feel bad that he hasn't come to the awareness of his responsibilities." He does not wish to meet with Fr. Foley. I reiterated that as a result of the Archdiocesan policy, Fr. Foley will not return to parish ministry but there may be other non-parish ministry available.

[REDACTED] is having problems with self - image and has recently had difficulty with depression. He has been away from therapy for a number of months. I urged for him to return so that he will be strong for his family. I offered assistance and he will discuss the situation with his wife.
