#### SPIRITUAL

We bring the good news of Christ. Retreats, days of recollection, prayer groups, intimate liturgies, spiritual direction. Evenings of spiritual renewal for individuals, groups, couples, elderly, students. Ecumenical Programs.

#### EDUCATIONAL

Seminars, lectures, consultations, live-in courses for professionals. Vocational and educational counselling, consultation to colleges.

#### SOCIAL

Facilities for parties, dining, dancing, movies, cocktail veranda (BYOB). We encourage people to come for coffee or a meal. A day, a night or a weekend...even to live for a week in our community. Staffed by residents, who for the most part have outside jobs, we offer the opportunity to experience living in a Christian community filled with the warmth and excitement of people seeking to develop a model for others, extending their own sharing of love to those who need Restoration and Renewal.

We treat guests, not as unwelcome interlopers, but as brothers and sisters coming home, sharing good times, and intimately experiencing the love of God.

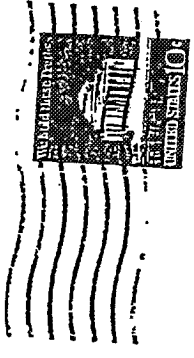
