Fr. was ordained a priest in 1974. Nost of the following years until 1984, he served on the faculty of Elder High School; an all boys discessan school. He served quite effectively there, much appreciated for his hard work, competent teaching, and extra-ducriclear faculty responsibilities.

In the fall.6f 1983, the priest principal reported that he had been contacted by parents of at least be obtainents. They said their sons had told them, since with others, they had been involved in parties in fr. private roces at the rectory of the earlies where he was in residence. During the parties, fr. had then take off their clothes and he touched their genitals. On at least some of these occasions, he had been drinking a cood bit and shared beer with them.

These accusations were brought to the strention of Fr. by the principle, in the presence of Fr.
Personnel Director. Fr. admitted having boys in his rooms, playing cames with them in which the person losing a turn had to take off an article of clothing. He admitted drinking beer, but not to excess. He admitted nothing further. Within a Few weeks, the same kind of reports were brought to the principal by several admitted students.

Fearing the real possibility of widespread scandal and possible further harm to students, as well as the recutation of the school, Fr was told that he would have to leave the faculty and the parish, the readily appread. He was strongly advised recentedly by Fr. so enter into professional counseling. We never did, to the bast of my knowledge.

Ne was them assigned to St. Christopher Parish, Near Bayson, Ohro, as Associate Pastor. He and the pastor, Fr. had known each other for some years and Fr. was very positivesabout the chance to serve with him. Mhile Fr. has expressed some concerns about Fr. companioning or junior high age boys, there have been no turther specific accusations of immoral behavior with boys while as St. Christopher.

Mowever, earlier this year a priest in another parish wrote to, me that a young man he was preparing for marriage told him that a very close friend of his was suffering emotionally because of incidents some years ago with Fr. They were described in much the same way as those allowen we above. I shared the letter with Fr. with the permission of the priest who sent it. Fr. responded that he did not do anything which would explain the young man's emotional disturbance.

On April 27, 1984, Fr. was arrested for DUI. He was required by the court to participate in an alcohol education program. Before and after this, Fr. said he had reasons to believe that Fr. was drinking quice a lot privately in his rooms. Upon our insistence, he submitted to an evaluation for the disease of alcoholism, and was diagnosed as being alcohol dependent. As a result, again at our insistence, he enrolled in an Alcohol Treatment Program (30 day) at Bethesda Base Hospital, Cincinnati. However, he did not participate afterwards in AA meetings or obtain an AA sponsor, etc. There are continuing signs that he is drinking to excess, according to Fr. He recently left a parish social event intoxicated and raw into a fence along the road and damaged his car. This was the first

incident of public intoxication in the presence of parishioners.
