

Meeting with John Maloney concerning Dan Clark  
11/14/88.

John believes Dan is cross-addicted - sex/alcohol and should be treated for both using an in-residence AA-12 step approach. A 30-day treatment process with <sup>①</sup> continuing individual therapy ~~and~~ <sup>②</sup> a sex-addict support ~~and AA group~~ group and <sup>③</sup> an AA group would be required.

John believes Dan should serve his 90 ~~plus~~ days uninterrupted by a treatment or assessment program. He needs the "experience of punishment" that jail will bring. He suggests treatment after this is over.

If Dan stays "clean" and "sober" for one year after treatment, he thinks he has potential for a job in a chemical dependency unit. During his year after treatment we will have to provide him some kind of work such as hospital chaplaincy.

John Maloney feels that Bob O'Connor probably does not understand the addictive part of Dan's condition.
