Alleged Abuse:

[REDACTED] reported that he attended St. John's School for the Deaf. He didn't live there because his parents had moved into Milwaukee so their deaf children could attend. [REDACTED] reports that he was thirteen at the time of the first incident. He was one of ten youths that went to Murphy's cabin as a reward for selling tickets for a raffle. In the mornings [REDACTED] stated that Murphy would come into the cabin where he and other youths were sleeping and wake him up, tapping hard on his penis. [REDACTED] stated that at the time, he was confused and wondered why Murphy would tap his penis and not another part of his body. This happened every morning.

[REDACTED] reported that he would drive a golf cart and clean the grounds during the annual Carnival. On one occasion, he stated that Murphy motioned with his finger for [REDACTED] to drive over to him. He was near the garage. [REDACTED] said that Murphy took him into the garage. Once in the garage, Murphy put his hand into [REDACTED] pants for approximately five minutes. [REDACTED] state that he had an erection, but didn't ejaculate. Afterwards, Murphy told him that he was doing a good job and to back to work.

[REDACTED] told this reporter that his memory isn't very good, but he remembers five incidents of Murphy touching his penis, just doesn't remember the details. [REDACTED] stated that he didn't get as much abuse as other youths because he didn't live at the school. [REDACTED] confided recently with his sister, [REDACTED] who encouraged him to come forward.

History:
