- 1. You may not celebrate Mass publicly or administer the sacraments. You are permitted, however, to celebrate Mass privately or with other priests at Villa Louis Martin in Jemez Springs.
- 2. You may not wear clerical garb, and you may not present yourself publicly as a priest.
- 3. You may not participate in the annual convocation and assemblies for priests.

I appreciate your cooperation in continuing to abide by these directives. I am grateful for your commitment to a life of prayer and penance as reparation for your past misconduct.

A Pastoral Letter to the People of God in the Diocese of San Diego

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

As you know from my letter to you in June, I am resolved to address cases of the sexual abuse of minors by priests "with transparency and openness, within the confines of respect for the privacy and reputation of the individuals involved."

Recently, three male adults made allegations of childhood sexual abuse against Monsignor Rudolph Galindo, a priest of this diocese who retired in 1986. Within the past several weeks, I investigated these allegations and met with Monsignor Galindo who admitted that they were true, accepting at the same time full responsibility for his conduct.

From my investigation, I am concerned that there are others who may have been harmed by sexual misconduct on the part of Monsignor Galindo during his various assignments as a priest. Wholeheartedly committed to the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, I invite any such persons to contact me in order that I might extend to them the pastoral outreach of the Church. I have directed the chancellor, Monsignor Steven Callahan, to personally receive any responses to this invitation at 858-490-8310 or Post Office Box 85728, San Diego, 92186.

Once again, I want to assure you that, to my knowledge, we have no priests in active ministry who have sexually abused minors. In the rare situations in which there has been the abuse of minors, we have acted promptly to keep children and young people from risk and to reach out with pastoral concern and care to victims and their families. Moreover, we cannot lose sight of the fact, as you know from experience, that most of our priests are loving and selfless servants of whom we can all be proud.

In his homily for the closing Mass of World Youth Day in Toronto, Pope John Paul II said that "the harm done by some priests and religious to the young and vulnerable fills us all with a deep sense of sadness and shame." But, he added, "think of the vast majority of dedicated and generous priests and religious whose only wish is to serve and do good." These deserve our gratitude and support!

Retired priest admits abuse, bishop says

Brom bars clergyman from ministry, urges victims to speak up



In the ongoing scandal of priests molesting children, San Diego Catholic Bishop Robert Brom has revealed that a retired priest admitted sexually abusing three men when they were minors.

Brom has barred that priest from ministry and has asked other victims to come forward.

The diocese turned over the name of Monsignor Rudolph Galindo to San Diego District Attorney Paul Pfingst this week.

"We're investigating to see if it's a prosecutable case," Pfingst said, adding that it will be a priority because there are accusations by more than

one victim.

In a letter released yesterday and to be shared with parishioners this weekend, Brom said the three men contacted the diocese with allegations of childhood sexual misconduct by Galindo, a priest who retired in 1986. When Brom met in his office with Galindo late last month, the 73-yearold priest admitted that the accusa-

tions were true and took "full responsibility for his conduct," the bishop wrote in his pastoral letter.

Under the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People adopted by U.S. bishops in June, any priest or deacon who sexually abuses a minor — past or present — is to be permanently barred from ministry.

"I have prohibited Monsignor Galindo from presenting himself as a priest or from functioning as a priest in any way whatsoever, and he accepted Diego and Imperial counties.

Galindo had been living in a retirement home for priests in San Antonio, Texas, but apparently has not been active in ministry because of poor health: A spokesman at the Archdiocese of San Antonio said there is no indication that he served as a priest there.

Brom described Galindo as "very remorseful and very understanding of the seriousness of what has happened." He also said Galindo "freed me to say ... that he has admitted to the allegations brought against him. He is not in a posture to defend himself against these allegations."

Galindo served his first four years at St. Edward Roman Catholic Church in Corona. He spent the next decade at Our Lady of Guadalupe in Chula Vista.

that these are the consequences of his misconduct," Brom said in an interview.

While this is the first time he has taken such action since the charter was adopted. Brom said zero tolerance was in place in the diocese before the bishops met.

After the meeting with Galindo, Brom said he sent the retired priest to an undisclosed treatment center for a psychological evaluation.

"I need to be sure that children and young people will not be at risk, even though from this point he won't be presenting himself or functioning as a priest," the bishop said.

Brom's letter urges other possible victims of Galindo to contact the diocese and lists the phone number and address for the Rev. Steven Callahan, chancellor of the diocese.

"From my investigation, I am concerned that there are others who may have been harmed by sexual misconduct on the part of Monsignor Galindo during his various assignments as a priest," Brom wrote.

When asked why he issued this unusual appeal, Brom cited the newly adopted charter, which calls for dioceses to reach out to victims.

"I think it's the right thing to do," he said.

Mark Brooks, head of the local chapter of the Survivors Network of those Abused by Priests, a national victim's rights group, said he has "a lot of misgivings" about the bishop's request. SNAP suggests victims contact law enforcement.

This is not the first time that Galindo has been accused of sexual misconduct. In 1985, he paid \$75,000 to a then-19-year-old man who accused him of molesting him when he was an altar boy at St. Joseph Cathedral Galindo denied that allegation.

Brom would give no details about the new victims or incidents, saying the men were "very insistent on confidentiality." He did confirm that the diocese has paid no settlements.

"To guard the victims' identity, we're not going to give so much information that you'd only have to fill in the blanks," Brom said.

Since being ordained in 1954, Galindo served at six churches in San Bernardino, San Diego and Imperial counties. Brom said that the incidents occurred at a church in this diocese which covers San

In 1963, he transferred to Our Lady of Guadalupe in San Bernardino. Six years later, he went to Our Lady of Mount Carmel in San Ysidro, and in 1976, he was made pastor of St. Joseph Cathedral in downtown San Diego.

After the lawsuit was filed by the former altar boy, Galindo was sent in 1983 to Our Lady of Guadalupe in Calexico, where he stayed for three years until retiring because of declining health.

At Our Lady of Guadalupe Church in Chula Vista, one longtime parishioner said she doesn't believe that Galindo did these things.

"I have to hear it from the horse's mouth before I believe it — straight from the horse's mouth," said the parishioner, who did not want to be named.

Galindo built a new church and parish hall during his 10 years there, she said.

The monsignor is a former altar boy himself, having served at St. John of the Cross Church in Lemon Grove.

It's been a summer of turmoil for the Roman Catholic Diocese of San Diego as it grapples with the scandal of clergy sexual abuse that has rocked Catholic churches.

The names of 23 priests, accused of misconduct in cases that go back decades, were given to authorities in June. Some of the men are dead and several others have left the priesthood.

Since then, the diocese has given prosecutors names of three more priests from past files. Brom repeatedly has said that, to his knowledge, no priest who ever molested a child is in active ministry here.

Last month, the diocese acknowledged that a \$250,000 settlement was paid in December to a man who said he was molested when he was a minor by the late Monsignor William Kraft.

Brom emphasizes that these cases represent a small fraction of the priesthood.

"Most of our priests are loving and selfless servants of whom we can all be proud," he wrote in yesterday's letter.



Altar boy's suit against priest settled out of court

A lawsuit in which the former rector of St. Joseph's Cathedral was accused of sexual improprieties with an altar boy over a three-year period has been settled out of court for \$75,000.

The priest, Monsignor Rudolph Galindo, was removed from his post in 1982, before the suit was filed, and is now pastor of Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church in Calexico.

The settlement was made two weeks ago, according to Scott J. Kaisler, attorney for Linh Do, a Vietnamese relugee now 19 years old. Galindo's attorney, Thomas Sharkey, said his client would have no comment on the suit since a related suit by the youth's father is pending 'a'll

The case is one of two suits involving the Roman Catholic diocese of San Diego to be settled out of court this month.

Last week the diocese settled a suit filed by former seminarian Mark Brooks, who alleged that he was forced out of St. Francis Seminary after complaining about homosexual activities involving seminarians and priests, including some faculty mem-

Brooks' settlement was about \$15,000, plus cancellation of his seminary tultion debt of about \$7,000.

Kaisler sought to amend the original complaint, which named only Galindo as defendant, to include Bishop Leo T. Maher as a defendant.

In a memorandum filed April 5, Kaisler said his own investigation turned up facts suggesting that Maher was negligent in his supervigion of Galindo.

"Had Bishop Maher properly supervised the activities of defendant Galindo he would have discovered that defendant Galindo was expending substantial sums of money in an effort to 'court' the plaintiff, a minor child.

"These expenditures included monies expended for numerous visits to the Town and Country Hotel in San Diego, a vacation to the Hotel del Coronado in Coronado, visits to the Palm Springs Spa, a two-week cruise to Alaska and a vacation to Hawaii," the memorandum says.

Kaisler's memorandum said that Galindo testified in a deposition that his compensation from the Catholic Church amounted to \$600 a month. and that in addition to travel expenses, Galindo "also expended monies for tuition for a private school for the plaintiff, the purchase of articles of clothing and gifts of money to the minor child."

In his deposition, Galindo testified he had given Linh Do's parents \$5,000 for a down payment on a house, had paid \$2,200 for the private school tuition and bought Linh a piano for \$818. He also testified that he paid for karate lessons for Linh and opened a eavings account for him.

learned of the transaction in late 1981 and immediately complained to both Galindo and Maher. One daughter, who asked not to be identified, says the first letter of complaint to the bishop got no response. After a second letter, Galindo agreed to deed the property back to the widow.

The diocese will not comment on any internal investigation, but in 1982 Galindo transfered three pieces of property and a trust deed on another.

According to court records and interviews with people knowledgeable about the case, Galindo met Linh Do and his family in 1977, after the family had escaped Vietnam as refugees. The youth, then 12 years old, and his younger brother became altar boys at the cathedral, where Galindo was

Galindo has denied any sexual contact with Linh. In his deposition, Galindo said that early in the relationship Tin Do, Linh's mother, began asking him for money to help pay bills and for other relatives still in Vietnam.

The monsignor said he began giving the family small amounts of money, and in 1979 gave Tin Do and Thuc Do, Linh's father, \$5,000 from his personal account to make a do payment on a house "because I f sorry for them because they seem to be very wooderful and grack people ...

He also began taking Linh, a sometimes Linh's brother, on tri where Linh alleges that Galindo i duced him to have sex.

According to the deposition, Gal. do said that Tin Do began writi him letters, calling him on the tel phone and sexually proposition him in person. He said he consider some of the letters he received, as ing for money, as blackmall, and sa that in September of 1981 she d manded \$100,000 from him.

Kaisler's memo says the lawyer found individuals who, "because of the trust and confidence they reposed in the defendant ... were compelled to part with real property and other assets. Upon discovery of this exercise of undue influence, complaints were made to Bishop Leo Maher, at times in writing."

The attorney said in the memo that had Maher investigated, the bishop would have learned that Galindo was generating money and

spending it on Linh Do.

"If such an effort was actually undertaken by the bishop," the memo says, "he knew, or should have known, that defendant Galindo was pursuing a most unusual social relationship with a boy of the age of 13, 14 or 15 years of age. It is important to note that the molestations which occurred continued for approximately a two- to three-year period."

The reference to individuals who gave Galindo real property arises from a series of real estate transactions in the 1970s in which Galindo

acquired interest.

In one case tracked by The San Diego Union, an 85-year-old widow deeded half-interest in her home to Galindo in 1979, then rewrote her will to leave him the home, furnishings and any future dwelling she might buy.

The widow's two daughters
