- I, Bobbi R. Martin, being first duly sworn under oath, states as follows:
- 1. My date of birth is <u>4/13/58</u> and I am currently employed at <u>Loras College</u>
- Parish in Grand Mound, Iowa. In the spring of 1983, I received information that Father Janssen had been arrested for shoplifting in Clinton, had permitted boys under the age of majority to smoke marijuana at the rectory and also had shown pornographic movies on a new VCR he had purchased on Friday nights. He was also taking boys under the age of 18 to the drive-in movie theater with him. I saw him frequently jog around town in nothing but a very small pair of nylon running shorts and running shoes with no shirt and a large metal cross.
- 3. Two other individuals and myself felt these activities were completely inappropriate. We met with Monsignor Morrissey at that time at the Diocese offices. We explained our complaints in detail to him, but he did not appear interested in what we had to say. To my knowledge, no actions were taken against Father Janssen as a result of our specific complaints.
