With your permission, however, I shall confront him again with the contents of your letter, and follow through with your suggestions, particularly in light of what you and the Vicars suffice to be a scandal.

I would appreciate knowing if you have had any personal conversations with Father Buntel or if any of the Vicars have concerning scandal in his present assignment.
