This man, ordained in 1960, requested a transfer out of Needham for personal reasons. Following that he was in East Boston where he had to be hospitalized and ended up in Glenside Hospital in Jamaica Plain.

He was on Lend-lease to Calgary Alberta for two years (1966-69). He had to leave there because he was involved with a young woman; he disappeared with her for a while; and scandal was created.

He returned to Boston in 1968. Later he became pastor of St. Peter's in Dorchester and in 1987 he went to Sudbury. There are no notations after 1968 in his file.
