Dear Mr. Sullivan:

On May 1, 1979 I examined in my office Miss [REDACTED]. I have known her since 1975 when she first came under my professional care. At that time through the present time she has been employed as a domestic in the rectory at St. Frances X. Cabrini Church.

On the occasion of her original visit 6/13/75 she stated that she had been assaulted by a resident priest who had thrown her against a wall in the rectory at which time she sustained strains of her neck and upper dorsal spine. This episode produced extreme agitation and anxiety. She was given sedative medication at that time.

On May 1, 1979 Miss [REDACTED] arrived in my office accompanied by a young female with whom I am acquainted. The patient was in an extremely agitated condition, weepy and semi-hysterical stating that she had been assaulted by the same priest who had been involved in the original visit in 1975. Physical examination demonstrated a contusion over the right eye, abrasion at the corner of her lip on the right side and numerous petechia of the scalp in the left frontal area due to having had a large amount of hair forcefully pulled out by the roots. The patient was given Valium for sedation.

Miss [REDACTED] named as her assailant, Father Thomas Forry.

I have considered Miss [REDACTED] to be a straightforward and reliable woman and have no reason to doubt the accuracy of her statement.
