



With your appointment as dean, you are $\underline{\text{ex}}$ officio a member of the Diocesan Board for Educational Ministry.

In the post Vatican II era, all segments of the Catholic community have become increasingly more involved in the formation of policy. This is especially true in education, one of the principal ministries of the Church and an area of major concern to both clergy and laity alike.

Recognizing the importance of this involvement, and in order to achieve the more effective integration of programs and better utilization of resources, Synod II recommended that there be a single Diocesan Board to assist me in the formation of policies governing all of the educational ministries of the diocese. I accepted the Synod's recommendation and have established the Diocesan Board for Educational Ministry. All diocesan educational programs are within the purview of this Board: schools, religious education, youth ministry, evangelization and adult education, campus ministry, liturgy and prayer and Hispanic evangelization.

Each deanery is represented on the Board by the dean (or a pastor appointed as his regular alternate) and a qualified lay person. In addition, there are three at-large members, one of whom must be a woman religious. The active participation of all members of the Board in its deliberations will assure that the programs conducted by the diocesan offices are responsive to the needs of the parishes.

Your service to the priests and people of your deanery is deeply appreciated.




Dear Bishop Maher:

I, as Superior of the Sisters Servants of the Poor, wish to express my feelings regarding the possibility of Msgr. Galindo's change to another parish.

Our congregation staffs the Guadalupe Day Nursery. We at this moment are in need of a new nursery because the present one needs too many repairs and has been semi-condemned by the Health Department. I believe that Msgr. Galindo has the capacity to build a new nursery if he were to remain here for at least another year. We have been here for nearly twenty years and we would not like to see the nursery closed.

A new nursery would mean that we could care for more children. At the present time we are allowed care for only twenty-two children. With another nursery we could take care of the many children who have had to be rejected because of lack of space.

This would be separate from the \$8,000 project that will soon be funded by the Federal Government regarding the Satellite Center which was established because of Msgr. Galindo's efforts.

In the years that I have been here I have noticed that Msgr. Galindo is able to handle the many problems that arise in a parish as large as Our Lady of Guadalupe.

I feel that to change Msgr. Galindo at this time would be a great tragedy.



In the first place I profess my belief that God, the beginning and end of all, can be certainly known and therefore proved to exist by the natural light of reason from the things that are made, that is. from the visible works of the creation as a cause from its effects. Next I recognize and acknowledge the external arguments of revelation, that is, divine facts, especially miracles and prophecies, as most certain signs of the divine origin of the Christian religion, and I hold that these are altogether suited to the understanding of every age and of all men, also of our times. Thirdly, I likewise hold with firm faith that the Church, the guardian and exponent of the revealed Word, was proximately and directly founded by the true and historic Christ Himself, while He dwelt amongst us, and that she was also built upon Peter, the Prince of the Apostolic Hierarchy, and upon his successors to the end of time. Fourthly, I sincerely accept the teaching of faith as transmitted down to us from the Apostles through the orthodox Fathers in the same sense and even in the same wording; and, therefore, I wholly reject the heretical notions of the evolution of dogmas, which pass from one sense to another alien to that which the Church held from the start; and I likewise condenin every error whereby is substituted for the divine deposit, entrusted by Christ to His Spouse and by Her to be faithfully guarded, a philosophic system or the creation of a human consciousness, gradually refined by the striving of men and finally to be perfected hereafter by indefinite progress. Fifthly, I hold for certain and sincerely profess that Faith is not a blind religious sense making its way out of the hidden regions of the sub-liminal consciousness, morally tinged by the influence of heart and will, but is a true assent of the intellect to truth received from without by hearing, an assent whereby we believe to be true, because of the authority of the all-true God, whatever by the personal God, our Creator and Lord, has been spoken, testified and revealed.

"I further, with all due reverence, submit and with my whole mind adhere to all the condemnations, declarations, and ordinances contained in the Encyclical letter *Pascendi* and in the Decree *Lamentabili*, particularly regarding what is called the history of Dogma.

"I also reject the error of those who aver that the Faith proposed by the Church may be in conflict with history, and that Catholic dogmas in the sense in which they are now understood cannot be harmonized with the more truthful "origins" of Christianity. Moreover, I condenin and reject the opinion which declares that a Christian man of better culture can assume a dual personality, one as a believer and another as an historian, as if it were permissible for the historian to hold fast what his faith as a believer contradicts, or to lay down premises from which there follows the falsity or the uncertainty of dogmas, provided only that these are not directly denied. Likewise I reject that method of estimating and interpreting Holy Writ, which, setting aside the Church's tradition and the analogy of Faith and the rules of the Apostolic See, adopts the rationalists' principles and with equal arbitrariness and rashness considers criticism of the text the one only supreme rule. Furthermore, I reject the opinion of those who hold that a teacher of the science of Historical Theology or the writer on the subject must first put aside the notions previously conceived about the supernatural origin of Catholic tradition or about the divine aid promised for the perpetual preservation of each revealed truth; then, that the writings of individual Fathers must be interpreted solely by the data of science, without any reference to sacred authority, and with that freedom of judgment wherewith every profane record is usually examined.

"Finally and in general, I declare myself to be far removed from the error of the modernists who hold that in sacred tradition there is nothing inherently divine; or who-far worse stilladmit it in a pantheistic sense; so that thus there would remain only a bare simple fact equal to the ordinary facts of history, viz., that the school started by Christ and His Apostles finds, in the ages that follow, men to carry it on by their energy, their skill, and their genius. Wherefore most firmly do I retain and to my last breath will I retain the Faith of the Fathers of the Church concerning the sure endowment of truth, which

"I further, with all due reverence, submit and with my whole mind adhere to all the condemnations, declarations, and ordinances contained in the Encyclical letter *Pascendi* and in the Decree *Lamentabili*, particularly regarding what is called the history of Dogma.

"I also reject the error of those who. aver that the Faith proposed by the Church may be in conflict with history, and that Catholic dogmas in the sense in which they are now understood cannot be harmonized with the more truthful "origins" of Christianity. Moreover, I condemn and reject the opinion which declares that a Christian man of better culture can assume a dual personality, one as a believer and another as an historian, as if it were permissible for the historian to hold fast what his faith as a believer contradicts, or to lay down premises from which there follows the falsity or the uncertainty of dogmas, provided only that these are not directly denied. Likewise I reject that method of estimating and interpreting Holy Writ, which, setting aside the Church's tradition and the analogy of Faith and the rules of the Apostolic See, adopts the rationalists' principles and with equal arbitrariness and rashness considers criticism of the text the one only supreme rule. Furthermore, I reject the opinion of those who hold that a teacher of the science of Historical Theology or the writer on the subject must first put aside the notions previously conceived about the supernatural origin of Catholic tradition or about the divine aid promised for the perpetual preservation of each revealed truth; then, that the writings of individual Fathers must be interpreted solely by the data of science, without any reference to sacred authority, and with that freedom of judgment wherewith every profane record is usually

"Finally and in general, I declare myself to be far removed from the error of the modernists who hold that in sacred tradition there is nothing inherently divine; or who-far worse stilladmit it in a pantheistic sense; so that thus there would remain only a bare simple fact equal to the ordinary facts of history, viz., that the school started by Christ and His Apostles finds, in the ages that follow, men to carry it on by their energy, their skill, and their genius. Wherefore most firmly do I retain and to my last breath will I retain the Faith of the Fathers of the Church concerning the sure endowment of truth, which

is, has been, and ever will be in the succession of the Episcopate from the Apostles; not in such a way that what seems best and most fitting according to the refinement of each age may be held, but that the absolute and unchangeable truth preached from the beginning by the Apostles may never in any different wise be believed, never in any different wise be understood.

All this I promise that I will faithfully, entirely and sincerely keep and inviolably guard, and from this never in teaching or howsoever by word or writing in the least depart. So I promise, so I swear, so help me God and these

Securities shall be purchased by the Trustee in the name of the Trustor for the benefit of beneficiary at the rate of one (1) \$50 debenture for each installment or number of installments aggregating the sum of \$50 until the entire purchase price is represented by debentures. The written statement of Mortuary, or its successor in interest, certifying that it has sold to Trustee and furnished the services which were selected as herein provided, or which were as nearly similar in kind and price as those designated in the "Pre-Need Agreement for Funeral Services" attached hereto, or which were necessary to the proper disposal of the remains of the beneficiary. together with a copy of the death certificate certified by the public officer having custody of the original, evidencing the fact of the death of the beneficiary, and a receipt showing full payment of that portion of the purchase price of the services for which Trustee is chargeable shall be a complete release and discharge to Trustee under the terms of this paragraph and shall be the only requisite evidence that Trustee has fully carried out and performed the terms of this trust. Trustee shall not be liable for any act or omission of Mortuary in the rendering of its services.
- 5. DISCHARGE OF TRUSTEE: It is understood that this trust is created for the purpose of providing for the beneficiary a funeral service, insofar as possible, in accordance with Trustor's wishes as herein expressed. Trustee shall be fully discharged upon using the trust estate for the procurement of the services designated by Trustee or in the event the designated services are unavailable, other services necessary in its discretion for the proper disposal of the remains of the beneficiary. In the event the designated services may not be obtained, it is further understood that it is Trustor's desire and direction that the services herein provided for be furnished by Mortuary and that the directions contained herein are mandatory and are to be carried out by Trustee in accordance with the terms hereof insofar as possible. DEATH BENEFIT

Payment of Proceeds

Upon receipt of proof of the Insured's death while this Contract is in force, the proceeds will be paid to the beneficiary. The proceeds will be paid in one sum or as agreed to by you and the Order. Proceeds payable to the beneficiary in one sum may, at the election of the beneficiary, be paid under any settlement option offered by the Order at the time of the Insured's death.

Proceeds

Unless the Contract is continued under a nonforfeiture option, the proceeds payable at the death of the Insured will be the sum of:

- 1. the Contract Amount;
- 2. any dividends and interest thereon deposited with us as of the date of the Insured's death;
- a fractional part of the dividend that would have been payable on the Annual Contract Date following the Insured's death. The fraction will equal the number of completed months from the last Annual Contract Date divided by twelve;
- any premium paid beyond the month in which the Insured dies; and
- 5. any insurance provided under dividend additions; less:
- any unpaid premium for the month in which the Insured dies; and
- 2. the unpaid balance of any loan and loan interest.

Claims of Creditors

To the extent permitted by law, the proceeds will not be subject to claims of creditors.

DIVIDENDS

Dividends

This is a participating Contract. This means that dividends will be paid annually on this Contract from our surplus funds on an equitable basis as determined by our Board of Directors. No dividends should be expected before the second Annual Contract Date. You may choose to use dividends under any of these options:

- I. paid in cash;
- 2. applied toward premium payments;
- 3. deposited with us to accumulate at interest. The rate of interest will be set by us from time to time, but at not less than 2% per year; or
- used to buy dividend additions. These are paid-up additional amounts of insurance.

If on the dividend date you have not chosen one of these options, option 4 will apply.

Dividends deposited with us, plus interest thereon and the cash value of dividend additions may be withdrawn at any time, unless required as security for any loan.

GUARANTEED VALUES

Cash Value

The guaranteed cash values of this Contract are shown in the Table of Values on Page 3A. The guaranteed cash values shown are as of the end of the Contract Year when all premium payments due have been made and when there are no loans. Guaranteed cash values during the Contract Year are determined by allowing for time elapsed and premium payments made during that Year.

The net cash value of this Contract is determined by adding the guaranteed cash value, any dividend deposits and the cash value of any dividend additions and subtracting the unpaid amount of any loans.

Cash Surrender

You may discontinue premium payments and surrender this Contract for its net cash value. This may be done upon your written request anytime prior to the 60th day after the first unpaid premium. We may defer this payment of net cash value for up to six months.

Nonforfeiture Options

If this Contract has net cash value, you may discontinue premium payments and elect one of the nonforfeiture options described below:

- 1. Paid-Up Insurance You may continue this Contract in force as Paid-Up Insurance which takes effect as of the due date of the first unpaid premium. The amount of Paid-Up Insurance will depend on the net cash value. If the net cash value equals the guaranteed cash value, the amount of Paid-Up Insurance will be that shown in the Table of Values. Paid-Up Insurance is participating and has its own net cash value which may be obtained at any time by surrendering this Contract. If the Contract is surrendered within 31 days after any Annual Contract Date, the cash value will not be less than that on such Date. At the Insured's death, the Paid-Up Insurance will be adjusted for loans and dividends placed under options 3 and 4.
- 2. Extended Term Insurance You may continue this Contract in force as nonparticipating Extended Term Insurance. The amount of this Extended Term Insurance will be the Contract Amount less the unpaid amount of any loan. The limited time during which the Contract continues in force will begin at the date the first unpaid premium was due. The duration of this Extended

Term Insurance depends on the net cash value. If the net cash value equals the guaranteed cash value, the duration will be that shown in the Table of Values. Extended Term Insurance has its own guaranteed cash value which may be obtained at any time by surrendering the Contract. If the Contract is surrendered within 31 days after any Annual Contract Date, the cash value will not be less than that on such Date.

Your written election of a nonforfeiture option may be made anytime prior to the 60th day after the first unpaid premium. If you do not choose an option prior to this day, then the Extended Term Insurance option automatically takes effect as of the due date of the first unpaid premium.

Computation of Values

Cash values are computed under the Standard Nonforfeiture Value Method. The guaranteed cash value is based on 4 1/2% interest, the use of continuous functions and the Commissioners 1980 Standard Ordinary Mortality Table. For Extended Term Insurance, the Commissioners 1980 Extended Term Insurance Table is used. A detailed statement of the method of calculation has been filed with the insurance supervisory officials of the jurisdiction where this Contract is delivered. All values are not less than those required by law.

LOANS

Cash Loans

Unless this Contract is being continued as Extended Term Insurance, you may obtain a cash loan upon written request. Sole security for such a cash loan will be this Contract. We have the right to defer cash loan requests for up to six months unless the loan is for the purpose of premium payment. The amount of the cash loan may not exceed the sum of:

- the guaranteed cash value at the next premium due date or the next Annual Contract Date, whichever is earlier; and
- 2. the cash value of any dividend additions as of such date;

less:

- 1. any due and unpaid premium;
- 2. any existing loan; and
- interest on the amount loaned to the next premium due date or the next Annual Contract Date, whichever is earlier.

Automatic Premium Loans

If this option has been requested in writing, and this Contract has net cash value, then any premium not paid after the Grace Period will be paid by automatic premium loan, if the net cash value is sufficient to pay it. You may revoke your written request at any time.

Loan Interest and Repayment of Loans

The Maximum Rate is the greater of the Published Monthly Average for the calendar month ending two months before the date on which we set our rate, or the rate used to compute the cash value during the applicable period plus 1% a year. The Published Monthly Average means Moody's Corporate Bond Yield Average — Monthly Average Corporates as published by Moody's Investors Services, Inc., or its successor. If Moody's Corporate Bond Yield Average — Monthly Average Corporates is no longer published, the Published Monthly Average will mean the rate set by the insurance regulatory agency where this Contract is issued. Subject to the provisions of the next paragraph regarding changes in interest rate, our loan interest rate will not exceed the Maximum Rate.

Once each Contract Year, we will determine a new Maximum Rate. Our loan interest rate may be increased, by no less than 1/2%, to a rate equal to or less than the new Maximum Rate, if the new Maximum Rate is at least 1/2% higher than our loan interest rate for the preceding year. If the new Maximum Rate is 1/2% or more lower than our loan interest rate for the preceding year, our loan interest rate will be reduced to a rate equal to or less than the new Maximum Rate. We will give notice of the initial loan interest rate in effect when you make a loan. If you have an outstanding cash or premium loan, we will send reasonable advance notice of any increase in rate. All notices will be mailed to your, and any assignee's, last known address.

Loan interest is due on each Annual Contract Date. If not paid, it will be added to the principal and bear interest at the prevailing rate. This Contract will not terminate during a Contract Year as the sole result of an increase in interest rate during that Contract Year. Subject to this, if the loan exceeds the guaranteed cash value, any dividend deposits and the cash value of any dividend additions, this Contract terminates 31 days after we mail notice of termination.

All loans made prior to a nonforfeiture option taking effect may be repaid in whole or in part while the Contract is in force other than as Paid-Up Insurance or Extended Term Insurance. Any loan made after the Paid-Up Insurance option takes effect may be repaid while the Contract remains in force.

PREMIUM PAYMENTS AND REINSTATEMENT

Premium Payments

Premium payments, as shown on Page 3, must be paid in advance at the Home Office. The first one is due on the Register Date. You may change the frequency of payment by notifying us in writing. Except as provided below, no premium payment will keep this Contract in force beyond the next premium due date.

Grace Period

There is a 31 day Grace Period to pay each premium, except the first. During this Grace Period, this Contract will remain in force.

Reinstatement

Should this Contract lapse for failure to make any payment due, it may be reinstated within three years of lapse; if it has not been surrendered for its net cash value. To reinstate this Contract you must:

- 1. submit proof of insurability which meets our standards;
- 2. make all overdue premium payments with compound interest at 6% per year; and
- 3. pay or reinstate any loans existing at the time of lapse, with compound interest at 6% per year.

OWNERSHIP AND BENEFICIARY

Owner

The Insured is the owner of this Contract unless:

- another person is named as the owner in the application;
- the Contract is assigned, in which case the assignee shall be deemed the owner; or
- 3. the Insured has not reached the age of 18 as of the date of application.

If the Insured has not reached the age of 18 as of the date of application, the applicant shall be deemed the owner of the Contract unless:

- 1. the applicant designates some other person as owner;
- 2. the Contract is assigned either to the Insured or to some other person; or
- 3. the applicant fails to make premium payments until the Insured reaches the age of 18. In such event, the Order shall designate as owner either the Insured's legal guardian or the person who agrees to make premium payments.

The owner may exercise all rights set forth in this Contract.

Death of Owner

If an owner other than the Insured dies while the Insured is living, all rights of the owner shall pass to the owner's estate unless otherwise provided.

Assignment

This Contract may be assigned. No assignment will bind us until we receive a signed copy at the Home Office. The Order is not responsible for the validity of assignments.

Beneficiary

The beneficiary is named in the application. While the Insured lives, the owner may change the beneficiary, unless this right is restricted by operation of law or unless the owner gives up this right.

Change of Beneficiary

To be binding, a change of beneficiary must be in writing and received at the Home Office. It will then take effect as of the date it was signed, but it will not apply to actions taken by us before it was received.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Entire Contract

The following constitute the entire contract between you and the Order:

- 1. this Contract and any attached riders or endorsements;
- 2. the application, a copy of which is attached to this Contract; and
- 3. the Order's Laws. Any change in our Laws after the Issue Date will apply to this Contract, but benefits granted by this Contract will not be reduced by future changes in these Laws.

The consideration for this Contract is the application and the payment of premium. The laws of the state or province where this Contract is issued for delivery control the rights and duties of the owner and any person rightfully making claim under the provisions of this Contract.

Change or Waiver of Provisions

No subordinate council, agent or member of the Order may change or waive the provisions of this Contract. No change in this Contract is valid unless it is made in writing and signed on behalf of the Order by the Supreme Knight or the Supreme Secretary.

Statements in the Application

Statements in the application are representations, not warranties. No statement will be used to void this Contract or to deny a claim, if it is not in the

copy of the application attached to this Contract when issued.

Incontestability

We will not contest this Contract after it has been in force during the Insured's lifetime for two years from the Issue Date, except for nonpayment of premium.

This provision will apply anew from the date this Contract is reinstated with regard to statements made in an application for reinstatement.

Suicide Exclusion

If the Insured dies by suicide within two years after the Issue Date, we will pay only the total amount of premium payments, less any indebtedness.

Age and Sex

The Insured's Issue Age is stated on Page 3. It is the age on the Insured's birthday nearest the Register Date. If the Insured's age or sex is misstated, the Contract Amount will be that which the premium would have bought at the true age and sex.

Currency

Every payment by or to the Order shall be in the lawful money of the country in which the application for this Contract is signed.

Maintenance of Solvency

The premium rates and benefits as specified in this Contract will not change. If the Order's reserves were to become impaired, the Board of Directors could require you to pay an equitable amount to eliminate the deficiency. Such amount could either be charged as

a loan against the Contract with interest compounded at 5% per year, or with your consent, deducted from the insurance benefit.

Membership

Even if the applicant ceases to be a member of the Order, you may keep this Contract in force by making the required premium payments.

Spouse's Right to Apply for Insurance

In addition to the other rights and benefits provided under this Contract, after the Insured's death the Insured's spouse shall have the right to request insurance coverage: (1) on his or her life; and (2) on the lives of the Insured's minor children. This right must be exercised within 90 days following the Order's receipt of proof of the Insured's death. The insurance coverage requested will be issued, provided that satisfactory evidence of insurability is submitted to the Order. The date the insurance coverage takes effect will depend upon: (1) the rules of the Order, and (2) the date the Order accepts the evidence of insurability.

For purposes of this provision, the following definitions apply: "insurance coverage" includes all plans of life insurance and annuities offered by the Order at the age and premium class of the proposed insured at the time of the exercise of this right; "Insured's minor children" includes all children, stepchildren and legally adopted children of the Insured who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of the date insurance coverage is requested; and "Insured's spouse" means the person to whom the Insured is married as of the date of the Insured's death.
