The 159th Provincial Council Meeting was held on March 17th, 1962 at the provincia house inw innetka, Illinois with all the councilors being present .

The meeting opened with a prayer. Then, Father provincial brought up the matter of Father George Kanoti's lst appointment. The rector and the superior of St. John Cantous Seminary recommended that Father Kanoti be sent to Catholic University in Washington ,D.C. for his fifth year to receive a licentiate in theology. The provincial council voted to accept the recommendation. The vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next on the agenda was the proposition submitted by Father Capiga as to the opening of a mission church in Burlington, Canada. The proposition received a favorable response from the councillors and all voted affirmatively to open the mission with the Fathers from Hamilton helping out to round the parish.

Thirdly, a motion nad been made for the nomination of a new superior at St. Stanisalus Kosyka in Hamilton, Canada. The suggestion was made that Father Capiga be nominated for the superiorship. This suggestion made by the provincial was received afavorably and the vote was in the affirmative by all concillors. It was suggested that the first councillor be Father Edward Gira, C.R. and the second councillor be Father John Miles, C.R. Both were approved unanimiusly by the councillors.

Transfers: Father Anthony Baran was transfered to St. Hyacinth from St. Stanisalus Rists and Martyr. Father John Miles, presently at St. John Cantius parish, will be transfered to St. Stanialaus Church in Hamilton, Canada. Father Jim Prusinski will be trasnfered to St. Stanisalus B.M. from the provincial nouse. All these transfers were approved by the council members.

The following recommendation were made by the provincial council and were to be tentaive-namely, Father Henry Stee would be transfered to Healsburg, California. Father George Kowalczyk from the pastorate to St. Hedwigs in Chicago; Father Kurlandski from Gordon Tech to St. Joseph's in Fontana California.

Brother Claude Tatarowicz, by the consent of the council, was to be transfered from the novitiate to Gordon Tech high.

At a brief meeting, the council voted for the new superior of Gordon Tech. Two men were suggested, and finanly after some discussion Father Louis Tusinski was nominated for the position. Father Louis Gracz indicated that a man from the house and with such qualoties as inherent in Father Tusinski would be the best choice. All councillors agreed to nominate him. The Grander work for shelper was anything to had come. Th meeting closed with a prayer.

revincial Superior Brumwykr, [], E KOWALCZYK-BBK000018 The 163rd meeting of the Provincial Council met in winnetka, Illinois at the provincial house on September 15th, 1962. All members of the provincial council were present.

After a brief prayer, which opened the meeting, Father Provincial informed the council that he received a letter from the archbishop of Atlanta, Georgia, His Excellency the Most Rev. Paul Halliman, in which the archbishop asked for recapitulation on a previous request made before his predecessor as to establishment of a parish in his diocese. The request as to the establishment of a parish was submitted by Bather Walter Mikosz, C.R., director of our appeals in the South.

The council discussed this issue and brought forth the following reasons for declining, for the present, to expand into the Atlanta diocese -namely, lack of man-power and desire to keep the goodwill of the bishop of Montgomery, Alabama where our present appeal originates. The provincial council unanimously voted to have Father Provincial forward a letter stating that due to the lack of men we would not be able to establish a parish within the next few years.

Next on the agenda was aletter from Father Byrns in Bolivia which had been sent to Father General and then forearded to our provincial. In the letter Father Burns indirectly asked for the transfer of Father Emil Stec who seems to cause an unhappy situation between himself and Father Charles Mrowinski, the pastor of the parish. It was noted in the letter that if Father Charles Mrowinski leaves, then he himself wants to leave also.

In view of the facts given, the council unanimously voted to transfer Father Emil Stec to the Chicago province and inform the general that no replacement would be forthcoming.

Thirdly, Father Provincial made a report that on Speember 7, 8 clerics and two co-adjutor brothers began their novitaite. On Sept.8th, five clerics made their vows and left for the major seminary in St. Louis, Missouri on Sept. 13th. Therefore, as of Sept. 15th, there are 17 in the novitiate.... 9 clerics, four brothers. In addition to these, there are two postulants for the co-adjutor brothers and two special Latin students for the clerical state.

The council also voted unanimously to renew for one yr. the pastorship of Father Albert Kowalczyk in Fontana, California. Moreover the council voted unanimously to renew for a second term the / superioship of Fr, Jerome Klingsborn whose term expires Oct. 1, 1962.

Final item at the meeting was a suggestion brought by Fr.L Gracz-namely, that the Haddon Bldg. be sold and a more functional bldg. be bought for the Polish Daily News, a bldg. with a one story and where the remodelling would not be to cookly.

The 166 meeting of the provincial come it met in Winnetka, Illinois at the

provincial house on December 8th, 1962. All members of the council were present.

New Pastor: After some deliberation by the council, it was decided unanimously to accept the suggestion of Father Provincial that Father Joseph Prusinski be considered for the pastorship of St.John Cantius Parish...to replace Father John Wojcik whose term comes to an end on January 16th, 1963. Father Felix Miliszkiewicz was voted unanimously in the affirmative to become the superior of St.John Cantius Parish...with Father Joseph Prusinski as the first councillor and Father John Mysliwiecz as 2nd councillor.

Some tentative changes: Suggested ,but not executed: Father Chester Norkiewicz to St. John Cantius Parish. Father Henry Szwaya to Father Galus' parish-ad paroechiam Dominae Nostrae Laureti. Brother Grabowski to remain in the novitiate and Brother Thomas Ivicki to be assigned to Weber High in Chicago, Illinois.

With these tentative changes, the meeting was closed with a prayer.

The 174th meeting of the provincial council met in Winnetka, Illinois on October 11th, 1963 with all the councillors being present. After the opening prayer, Father provincial informed the council that co-adjutor brother David Lata sent a petition in which he requested to allow him to make his first vows. Since the report on the novice was commenable, the council voted unanimously in the affirmative.

Father provincial also reported that on September 27th, 1963, Father Henry Krieger, C.R., resigned as vice-rector. of St. John Cantius Seminary In St. Louis, Mo. He stated in his letter that his resignation was due to the fact that there would be greater harmony between the rector and a new vice -rector, namely, Father George Kanoti, whom Father Henry Prieger suggested as a replacement. After some discussion as to the suggestion, three of the councillors and the provincial voted affirmatively to accept the resignation and the suggestion proposed by Father Krieger. The fourth councillor, Father Louis Gracz, did not agree with the suggested replacement and thus abstained from voting.

Thirdly, the provincial presented a rescript from the Sacred Conggregation of Religiouss for Father Joseph Kint, C.R., dated October 4,1963, permitting Father Kent a leave of abscenece for one year.

Pourthly, Father provincial notified the council that the term of office as pastor of St. Hedwig's Parish had terminated for Bather Joseph Laborowski, C.R. on Sept. 11, 1963. After some discussion, a vote was taken and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative... for re-appointment for abother three years.

Moreover, it was likewise voted unanimously to extend Father Albert Kowalczyk's term as pastor until January 20,1964.

Transfers:

Father Ted Napiorkowski, C.R. was assigned to St. Hedwig's Parish aa assistant from former residence at the provincial house.

Ather Gracz, asked for a voice and stated that of the twenty-one interviewed only three did not come to see me to tell me how appalled they were to hear the charges of calumny against me. The three were Fathers Dzielski, Wanat, and Socha. In the provincial suggested that a syllabus be issued for each course of studies in the high school...and with this the matter was dropped.

The second point on the agenda was the appointment of a new pastor for St.Mary of the Angels Parish.
