You will probably recall that I telephoned you a few weeks ago regarding my recent appointment as Prior of this Religious Community of Augustinians. I am also, I understand, Administrator of the Chapel here.

I am writing now to request in writing whatever authority I may have regarding:


1. Faculties of the diocese and delegating them to priests of our Order who may visit here, and especially if they assist in diocesan parishes on weekends as can often be the case especially in the summer vacation months.
2. Faculties for hearing the confessions of religious women. Do I have such faculties myself by reason of my office? Can I delegate them if I do? Need I request them in every case (i.e., for a period of time for individual confessors) from the Vicar for Religious?

I also request the ordinary faculties of the diocese for the following Augustinians who will be assigned here for the coming academic year, some of whom are already here: Fathers Thomas Bonica, John Kelly, Peter J. Marron (from St. Patrick's), John Ranallo, Anthony Wasko. Also, for Father Augustine Alonso who will be living here while pursuing graduate studies at UCSD.

I have been told various things regarding faculties here and the authority of previous Priors in that regard going back to the time of Bishop Buddy. I would prefer having something substantial for myself in such important matters.

Many thanks for any information and assistance you may be able to give me.

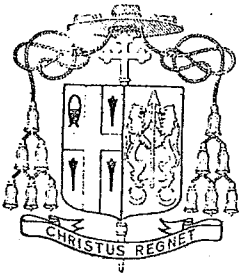

Right Reverend and dear Monsignor Bowe:

Permit me to answer your request for information of Father Victor Marron dated August 21, 1963.

Father Marron came to the Diocese of San Diego in April of 1961, and was immediately appointed assistant at Saint Pius X Church in Chula Vista. Since that time, Father has been assigned to five different parishes, being stationed in the last one, Precious Blood Church in Banning, since January 10, 1963. In each instance Father was moved at the request of the Reverend Pastor.

There has been no positive evidence of Father committing any moral wrong doings. However, I should say this, the Pastors received a number of complaints from parents objecting to Father's over familiarity with their children, especially their daughters.

Since Father has been given five different assignments in this diocese, and in each this item of complaint has been registered against him, His Excellency, The Most Reverend Ordinary, felt that it would be better for Father to get a new and fresh start elsewhere. Thus, he was asked to leave the Diocese of San Diego.

On the other side of the ledger, in fairness to Father Marron, I must say that the work assigned to him was always satisfactorily completed. He was always prompt and punctual for all appointments and for the celebration of the Sacred Mysteries.

Save only for Father's imprudencies, in all probabilities The Most Reverend Bishop would have been happy to keep him in the Diocese of San Diego.

I hope this will provide a complete and fair picture of Father Marron's situation.
