

This is to formalize the responsibilities and benefits as chaplain to Nazareth House. It is my understanding that in return for celebration of daily masses and visitation of the infirmary that you will be remunerated with the use of a house on Nazareth property. I do note in your letter of May 3, 1995, that you also hear confessions, administer the Sacrament of the Sick, celebrate Benediction and lead a Holy Hour.

Dear Monsignor Dan:

This is a request for a letter to the Superior of Nazareth House in re the Chaplain. You were to write it in February 193 and send me a copy but your Secretary was on Jury Duty and the letter was never written.Let's refresh your memory and how you became involved.

In the Fall of '92, Bishop Brom called me to his office at the Pastoral Center. His question was: "What are you going to do when you retire?" He got my response. Then he said: " Why don't you go as Chaplain to Nazareth House? They want you and they have a house for you." I accepted. Later that after-noon he phoned me and told me that Sister John was delighted I had chosen to come to Nazareth as Chaplain. He added, "I told her, ' you know Sister he will have to get a remuneration.' "

I had known Sister John since 1977. I wrote her for a job description, and thanked her for requesting the Bishop to assign me as their Chaplain. The response to my letter was a Thank You Note and the Irish colloquialism, "You'll do fine."

Before I went to Nazareth you had me come to your office to relay to me the Chaplain's Duties at Nazareth and remuneration according to Sister John: " Responsible for the Masses, visit the Infirmary once a week and the remuneration was the house."

You were to write Sister and tell her I would be responsible for the Masses for eleven months of the year, get a month's vacation. The Priest Supply and his stipend would be the responsibility of Nazareth House. The letter was never written.

Presently, I celebrate two Masses daily, 7.00 a.m. and 9.30 a.m., hear Confessions weekly, administer the Sacrament of the Sick to all the Residents (eligible because of age) monthly, Benediction, Holy Hour, visit the Infirmary once a week.

I got a vacation in '93, because I had made arrangements about a Supply when I was Pastor at Immaculate Conception. I took care of the stipend. Didn't get a vacation in '94. It was mentioned in the corridor, "You can take a vacation." I wasn't told any arrangements about a Supply.

I would like a letter to come from the Diocesan Office to Sister Margaret stating that The Chaplain is entitled: #

- a) Annual vacation of one month. Priest Supply and stipend responsibility of Nazareth House.
- b) Free to attend Convocation/Retreat
- c) One Day-Off yearly of 24 hours duration to visit relatives in Sherman Oaks and Northridge.

The "remuneration" the house, is not a palatial residence, built on an ant hill, you have to keep a supply of RAID. The Bishop was here at Christmas and I told hime I didn't get the remuneration he had in mind. He was surprised. I'm satisfied I'm not living in the lap of luxury. That is all for now.

It is with sadness that I inform you of the death of Monsignor Michael Cooney on June 29. He was ordained for the Diocese of San Diego in 1939. He served at St. John's and Our Lady of Angels in San Diego and St. Peter's in Fallbrook. When the diocese was divided, he was included in the Diocese of San Bernardino. A vigil service will be held on Thursday, July 2 at 7:30 p.m. at St. Anthony Church in Upland and a Requiem Mass will be celebrated there on Friday, July 3rd at 11:00 a.m. by Bishop Straling.

I regret to inform you that Bridget Byrne, mother of Father George Byrne, died at Nazareth House, June 28, 1992, at the age of 90. Services will be held in New Rochelle, New York, at 9:30 on July 2. A Memorial Mass will be held at Nazareth House where she lived for 12 years. Those arrangements will be made upon Father Byrne's return from New York.

It is with regret that I inform you of the death of Anna Margaretha Maria Kothuis-Van Sol, mother of Msgr. Hans Kothuis, who passed away on June 27 in The Netherlands. Msgr. Kothuis' address is Nunziatura Apostolica, Avenida Maximo Gomez 27, Apartado Postal 312, Santo Domingo Dominican Republic.

Let us in prayful reflection offer our Masses and prayers on behalf of the Cooney, Byrne and Kothuis families.

Open heart surgeries have been performed on Father John Nesbitt and Monsignor Patrick Kearney during the past week at Mercy Hospital. Please keep them in your prayers for a speedy recovery.

Lear Rishop Maker,

I'y family and I spent the weekend of March 4 and 5 in San Diego. We attended the 12:15 liturgy at Immaculate Conception in Old Town.

Everything was fine until midway through his homily, the priest stopped reading and after a brief pause asked scheone to leave because their children were being unruly. Then the priest got no response, he then said quite loudly and with a snap of his fingers and wave of his hand, "You there, in the second row, do you speak English???". The then again asked them to remove their "disruptive children". As the couple got up to leave with their children, the priest proceeded to inform the congregation that it's unfair to us all to have noisey hids in church. People want to hear what the priest is saying...AND THE FISUOP WANTS IT THAT WAY TOO!!"

After a brief moment of prayful meditation, I useded that I FUST make a statement against this blatent discrimination. So, I turned to my wife and said, I have to leave." For response was, "So do I." We walked out of church with our children (13 and 14 yrs. old), as did several other families (conservative estimate: some 25 people left the church.)

I am entremely offended that in 1989, this priest thinks it's alright to address people from the pulpit in such an unchristian manner, to embarrass and humiliate them in front of 300-400 people and then ask them to leave.

I am extremely offended that in 1939 this priest thinks it's O.K. to discriminate against our Catholic children and young Catholic parents.

We could hear the children in church but we never thought they were being "unruly". It was just normal behavior that one anticipates from small children when in church. As we spoke with other people that left Mass in protest, it was the general concensus that the priest was the one with the unruly behavior. We were all in shock.

The felt fortunate in being able to speak with the family who were kicked out of Mass. We told them that we too were angry, frustrated and shocked by this man's unchristian attitude and that we left in support of them and to make a nonverbal statement to him.

I containly hope that when that young family walked out of Immaculate Conception March 5th, that it wasn't for the last time. Or the last time for the others who left in support.

I am relieved that our non-Catholic friends were not with us! I would have been very embarassed and humilisted with them experiencing the superciliousness of this priest. To me he certainly does not represent my Catholic Church!





Your Excellency:

This is a follow-up note to inform you that Father Patrick Kearney will be released for limited duties this coming Tuesday or Wednesday, November 1st or 2nd.

During his recent stay in the hospital his condition has improved somewhat, however his cardiograms are still abnormal and he still witnesses an occasional bout of precordial distress. As previously stated Father should continue to avoid exertion or fatigue in the future. It would be permissible for Father to use the stairways provided he takes his time and there are not too many of them.

Father mentioned that there was a possibility of him being stationed in Cceanside which in my opinion would be quite suitable. At present I would recommend that Father's physical condition be reevaluated every four to six weeks for the present. Should he be stationed in San Diego I will refer him to an internist friend of mine practicing there. Should he be stationed close to Los Angeles I would be very happy to see him myself.

Should there be any further questions in regards to his case please feel free to contact me at any time.

Your Excellency,

I am writing to inform you of the fact that Father Patrick Kearney is at present in the St. Francis Hospital in Lynwood, California for the purpose of evaluating and further treating his cardiac status.

Father Kearney has just arrived from Chicago and I felt that it was necessary to re-hospitalize him because of his complaints. His physical status at the moment is satisfactory however there still presists definite evidence of coronary insufficiency and he is still subject to attacks of abnormal heart rhythm. In my opinion Father should be able to resume light to moderate activities on or about November 1, 1955.

Appropriate medical measures have been prescribed and Father has been advised as to his limitations from a physical standpoint. In brief he should avoid over exertion as in one instance by climbing stairs or steep hills and by all means he should avoid fatigue from any cause. Under appropriate conditions and medical treatment I feel that Father's prognosis is good, however it may be a number of months before the condition has been completely cured. I feel that it's also important that he have periodic medical check-ups and adequate medical supervision.
