The City of San Marcos, nestled in Los Vallecitos de San Marcos, was named by missionary fathers to California after St. Mark the Evangelist. The Most Reverend Charles F. Buddy, D.D., Bishop of San Diego, directed that a Catholic Church be established in March, 1963, and appointed Father William D. Spain as founding pastor.

For more than one year following the establishment of St. Mark's, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass was offered at the Meadowlark Ranch Theater — the Ol' Opry House — on Rancho Santa Fe Road. In April, 1964, Bishop Francis J. Furey approved the purchase of nearly eight acres located immediately east of Lake San Marcos. This acreage is sufficient for a church, rectory, school and convent. St. Marks' then purchased the San Marcos Lumber Company Storage building and had it moved to the church property for use as a temporary church and future hall. An addition to this building — the Annex — was built in 1966 and is now used for catechetical instructions, recreation and social purposes.

Mrs. Mildred Chervenka and her late husband, Charles A. Chervenka, were among the first to take an active interest in the formation of St. Mark's. This interest is further evidenced today by the presentation of a new Hammond Concert Organ to our Church.

The Hammond Concert Model Organ is to be found in some of the most magnificent Cathedrals and churches of the world. It has been designed for the discriminating organist and lovers of organ music who demand nothing less than the finest. Its conservative styling will lend gracious dignity to the future "St. Mark's." We accept this gift with the hope that our parishoners will be inspired to provide better music for our liturgical services. For music is the language of praise; and one of the most essential preparations for eternity is delight in praising God.
