# Ex-teacher sentenced in boys' molestations

Former Santa Paula high school teacher Stephen D. Field, 42, was sentenced to state prison Thursday for molesting two 13year-old boys. ?" 1 1 1

Superior Court Judge Lawrence Storch sentenced Field to a pair of six-year terms for two counts of performing lewd acts on a child under 14. Storch said the terms could be served at the same time."

Field, who last taught at Santa Paula High School, pleaded guilty to the two charges in May. He could have received up to 10 years in prison for each offense. greatly to sentence Field to prison. Field is married with three children and appeared to be a model citizen and teacher in every other area of his life, the judge said.

"The problem is this case, in my view, is that it would be a miscarriage of justice not to sentence Mr. Field to prison," Storch said.

He said that although Field's sexual misconduct was not the most serious he had seen, it was more serious than fondling. Also, Field took advantage of his lead ership position, as well as the trust and friendship he had with the boys.

"It also appears that this conduct has been going on for an

earlier instances of sexual misconduct that came to light during the preparation of Field's probation report.

The report says Field was asked to leave a Santa Monica Boy Scout troop in 1971 after complaints from boys in the troop.

Storch also referred to a 1982 incident similar to the two to which Field pleaded guilty. That incident involved a student in Thousand Oaks High School, where Field was teaching at the time. Charges were never filed, but Field quit and left the school district as a result. Storch said.

All the cases cited in the probation report involved the same scenario: After befriending a youth, Field would initiate sexual contact by first rubbing the youth's back, court records say. Over time, the back rubs lead to nude massages, and finally to intimate sexual contact, the reports say.

Field's lawyer, Barry Greenhalgh of Beverly Hills, argued that Field would be harmed, not helped, by a prison sentence.

"The probability of being more set in his deviate behavior will likely increase (if imprisoned)," said Harold Fonderen of LDS Social Services, a counseling service of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.

Fonderen, a licensed marriage, family and child counselor, is Field's therapist. Field started therapy soon after he was arrested, Fonderen said.

Fonderen testified that Field would best respond to a strict probation that would include intense therapy.

"The real persons that are going to be punished by his incarceration are his family," lawyer Greenhalgh said.

Deputy District Attorney Bill Karr had asked the judge to impose an eight-year prison term, the recommended sentence in Field's probation report.

"Having left a job after being caught, you'd think a man of Mr. Field's intelligence would realize he had a problem and get help," Karr said.

# 6-Year Term Given Ex-Area Teacher

A former Santa Paula High School teacher was sentenced Thursday to six years in prison for molesting two teen-age boys he had befriended.

Superior Court Judge Lawrence Storch rejected a defense request that Stephen Daniel Field, 42, of Fillmore be placed on probation, saying to do so "would be a miscarriage of justice."

Storch said he has seen many child molestation cases in his courtroom and this one "ranks among the more serious" because Field engaged in an "ongoing course of serious substantial sexual conduct with people who look up to the defendant."

Field's wife wept loudly when Storch announced the defendant would go to prison. Field had been free on bail, but he was taken into custody immediately after the sentencing.

Both victims in the case were 13 at the time of the molests. One of the boys, a former student of Field's at Thousand Oaks High School, was molested between June 1 and Aug. 31, 1985, and the other, who was in Field's church Boy Scout troop, was assaulted between June 1 and Dec. 31 of last year.

The probation report in the case says Field has been molesting teenage boys since at least 1971, when he was asked to resign as a Boy Scout leader because of his actions. He taught at Thousand Oaks High but resigned when his sexual activity with a boy at that school was discovered.

Field told the probation officer he then accepted a job at Santa Paula

High and chose to live in Fillmore to reduce the chance of having his students over to the house.

The probation report said Field asked members of his Boy Scout troop last year to sit nude in his hot tub and watch pornographic movies. Several nude photographs of teen age boys were discovered when he was arrested, some dating back 10 and 15 years.

The molestations usually began with a massage and then progressed to sexual activity.

Storch noted Field befriended boys so he could molest them. The probation report said Field made no attempt to befriend girls, or boys outside the 13 and 14 age range.

At the sentencing hearing, a neighbor and good friend of the Field family said she believed it would "devastate" the defendant's three children if Field went to prison. Storch said he had "a great deal of compassion for (Field's) family." and consequently he imposed only a six-year prison term instead of the eight years recommended by the probation department.

Harold L. Fondren, a marriage and family counselor who has met regularly with Field since April, said the defendant did not need a prison sentence to understand the destructive nature of his behavior. Fondren said Field probably would come out in worse shape than he is now if sent to prison.

But Fondren also testified that Field lied to him when he started counseling and did not seek help for his problem until criminal charges were filed against him.



#### Dear Paul:

With reference to your request concerning our factual data about the homosexuality of Stephen D. Field, the following investigation bore these facts:

- 1. The Troop Committee appointed Dr. Moulton K. Johnson, a medical doctor, to head up the committee of investigation and his letter is attached. Dr. Johnson and I have served on the Santa Monica Unified School District Board of Education for the past six years and I know him to be a man of great objectivity. His investigation shows that Stephen Field should no longer continue in any boys' program. We cannot obtain a statement from the father because he is of the mind that he will do nothing to help the establishment, which is a strange attitude but a sign of our times.
- I personally investigated with the school principal of Lincoln Junior High School, Harold Steinman, who for many years served as the Boys' Vice Principal. During this time, on three different occasions, three of the older boys who are students at his school, voluntarily came to him and described the activities that were going on in one of our Scout camps without the knowledge of any member of our camp staff. These actions involved the playing of strip poker by the older Scouts, and the

losers in the game, having no clothes left, were made to run around the camp at a late hour.

I asked Steinman why he did not report this to me and he said that he did tell Dr. Black, a medical doctor and psychiatrist, who is a member of the troop committee, and that he expected Dr. Black to take some action. But this Dr. Black did not, even though he is well-acquainted with Scout procedure and has served as a camp doctor for one or two weeks at Camp Emerald Bay over a period of years.

There is no question in my mind that this man can no longer continue as a leader in this council or in any capacity in this council and I have written the attached letter to him outlining this decision.

I am writing in my capacity as a member of the troop committee of Troup 11. One of the boys accused a scout master of talking him into homosexual activities on a number of different occasions. The boy's father was a member of the troop committee. Therefore the troop committee, acting without the father and having Dr. John R. Black as a sort of substitute, investigated the matter very thoroughly. We spent quite a few evenings on the subject, and I don't believe that the investigation could have been much more thorough. The troop committee was of the unahimous opinion that the charges were true. We therefore informed the scout master, Steve Fields, that he would have to resign as scout master. He has done this.

There is reason to believe that Mr. Fields is attempting to recruit some of the members of Troup 11 and have them join another troop where he will be active.
