

## Priest, Actors' Friend, Willed \$100,000

Rev. John O'Donnell, the Irish priest who won the hearts of many a movie mogul during the 15 years he was pastor of Culver City's St. Augustine Catholic Church, yesterday was willed the bulk of an estate estimated in excess of \$100,000.

Mrs. Martineau Conley Dalrymple, 67-year-old widow of Keith Dalrymple, Culver City businessman, bequeathed Father

O'Donnell all of her estate except \$10 in cash and a house valued at \$10,000. She died last Friday.

Her holographic will, dated May 4, 1943, and filed for probate in Superior Court yesterday, directed that the \$10 cash bequest go to her half-brother, Dr. Harry D. Conley, of Philadelphia. Dr. Conley, according to Mrs. Dalrymple's attorney, Lawrence P. Scherb, is wealthy in his own right. He is the deceased woman's only living relative.

The will also directed that Mrs. Dalrymple's physician, Dr. Edgar G. Zinn, of 3655 Motor Ave., be given her former home at 3370 Canfield Ave. The remainder of the estate, Mrs. Dalrymple directed in the testament written completely in her own hand, goes to Father O'Donnell, named as executor.

Father O'Donnell, now at Immaculate Heart of Mary Church, 4954 Santa Monica Blvd., is well known in the film colony and his transfer from Culver City in 1938 brought a host of objections from loyal parishioners.
