## Fr. Morrin, 54, Dies on Visit To Cambridge

Rev. Thomas M. Morrin, O.M.I., 54, a native of Boston who was assigned to the Oblate Fathers House in Newburgh, N.Y., died this morning.

He died at Cambridge City Hospital after becoming ill while visiting his sister, Mrs. Winifred Keegan of Cambridge.

Fr. Morrin attended Cathedral Grammar and High School, Boston, where he was all-Catholic football player and also starred in baseball and basketball.

After attending Boston College for one year, he entered the Oblate Novitiate at Tewksbury in 1932. He was ordained May 30, 1939, in Washington, D.C.

He served at Immaculate Conception Church, Lowell, and also in Fayetteville, N.C.; Petersburg, Va.; West Jefferson, O.; Essex, N.Y.; Toledo, O., and most recently in Newburgh.

He was on the Oblate Mission Band, which preached missions and novenas.

The Office of the Dead will be said Monday at 10 a.m. at the Oblate Novitiate Chapel, Tewksbury, and will be followed by a solemn high requiem Mass. Burial will take place in the Oblate Cemetery, Tewksbury.
