

## St. Mary's Will Honor Father Egan

The Rev. John F. Egan, former assistant pastor at St. Mary's Church, will be honored by three parish organizations June 10 at a dinner at Eastover.

Father Egan was forced by ill health to leave St. Mary's and at present is recuperating at his family home in Weymouth and is awaiting reassignment, according to a parish spokesman.

The dinner will be sponsored by St. Mary's Rosary Society, Men's Club and Church Council. It will be followed by a dance.

Father Egan will be honored for his service to St. Mary's and for his 40 years in the priesthood.

A native of Boston, Father Egan spent 19 years as a Trappist monk, leaving the order because of ill health. He came to Pittsfield in 1952.
