Maj. John P. Donahue, 37, brother of Senate ex-chief

HOLYOKE — A pontifical concelebrated liturgy of Christian burial will be sung tomorrow at 10 a.m. in St. Jerome's Church for Maj. John Paul Donahue, an Air Force chaplain who died Tuesday at Lowry Air Force Base Hospital, Denver.

Fr. Donahue, 37, died of hepatitis contracted during his 18-month tour of duty in Thailand. He is the brother of former Massachusetts Senate President Maurice A. Donahue.
