

Fr. Schinkten Rites Scheduled For Friday

DE PERE — The funeral will be held Friday for the Rev. Arnold J. Schinkten, O. Praem., who died Tuesday.

Father Schinkten, 61, was born Feb. 25, 1915 in Sturgeon Bay to Henry and Mary Schinkten. He got his bachelor's degree from St. Norbert College and his master's in education and psychology from Catholic University, Washington, D.C. He was ordained a priest July 2, 1943.

Most recently a teacher at St. Norbert College, he taught high school in Philadelphia, Pa., and at Green Bay Pre-montre. During the summers of 1942-1969 he counseled and taught horseback riding at Camp Tivoli, Cecil.

Survivors include two sisters, Mrs. Kenneth (Marie) Anderson, De Pere, and Mrs. Clarence (Marge) Paul, Sturgeon Bay; and a brother, Adolph, Sturgeon Bay. He was preceded in death by his parents and three brothers.

The funeral Mass is scheduled for 4:30 p.m. at St. Norbert Abbey.
