

Rev. Msgr. David Francis Budney, retired Priest of the Diocese of Camden; aged 83 years, of St. Augustine, Fl.; formerly of New Jersey and New York, peacefully passed away on March 30, 2014.

LEGACY

Born in New York, NY; Msgr. Budney earned his bachelor's Degree from St. Joseph's College and completed his Graduate Studies at Our Lady of Angels in Albany, NY and Villanova University, Philadelphia, PA. Msgr. Budney was ordained into the Priesthood in 1957 and served the Diocese of Camden for the next 46 years. Msgr. served numerous parishes throughout the Diocese as Parochial Vicar; including; St. Joseph Pro-Cathedral, Camden; Our Lady Star of the Sea, Atlantic City; St. John, Collingswood; Our Lady Star of the Sea, Cape May. Msgr. served as Pastor at St. Michael's, Cedarville; St. Margaret, Woodbury Heights and St. Thomas More, Cherry Hill prior to his retirement in 2003.

Additionally, Msgr. Budney taught at several High Schools throughout the Diocese in the early years of his career. During his years of service to the Catholics of Southern New Jersey; Msgr. earned the respect of his peers and leaders of the Diocese. By virtue of his gifts; Msgr. earned appointments to several Councils within the Diocese including the Inter-Parochial Cooperation Plan Board for three terms; Presbyteral Council for two terms and in 1992 earned the distinguished honor of Vicar General for the Camden Diocese.
