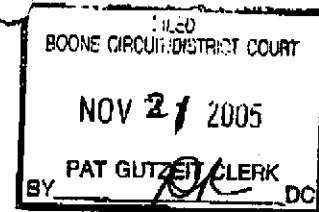

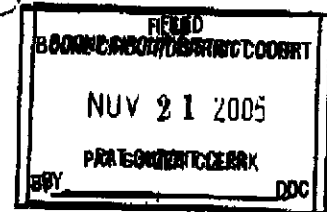

Comes the Affiant, Robert A. Steinberg, and after being duly cautioned and sworn, states as follows:

1. My name is Robert A. Steinberg. I am co-counsel for Plaintiffs in the above captioned case.
2. The newspaper publication attached hereto as Exhibit 1 was published in the newspapers listed in Exhibit 1a beginning July 22, 2005 and ending August 25, 2005. There were 141 separate publications nationally, regionally, and locally on the specific dates and pages set forth in Exhibit 1a.

August 28, 2005 on the major television stations in Bowling Green, Ky., Lexington, Kentucky, Louisville, Ky., and Cincinnati, Ohio identified in Exhibit 2a on the specific times and dates set forth in Exhibit 2a.

4. The radio publication attached hereto as Exhibit 3 was broadcast 523 times beginning October 10, 2005 and ending October 30, 2005 on the radio stations in Bowling Green, Ky., Lexington, Kentucky, Louisville, Ky., and Cincinnati, Ohio identified in Exhibit 3a on the specific times and dates set forth in Exhibit 3a.

5. The newspaper publication attached hereto as Exhibit 4 was published on October 30, 2005 in the Sunday edition of the eight newspapers identified in Exhibit 4a on the specific pages identified in Exhibit 4a.

## If You Suffered Sexual Abuse\* By Anyone Affiliated With the Roman Catholic Diocese Of Covington, Kentucky

### A Class Action Settlement May Affect Your Rights

If you were the victim of sexual abuse by anyone affiliated with the Roman Catholic Diocese of Covington, Kentucky, you may be able to participate in a Settlement Fund. The plaintiffs have reached a Settlement agreement with the Diocese under which the Diocese will advance \$40 million from its assets into a Settlement Fund. The Diocese is also pursuing a claim against its own insurance carriers in the Federal Court to compel them to pay an additional \$80 million for the benefit of claimants into the Settlement Fund and to reimburse the Diocese for its \$40 million advance. The Diocese's claim against the insurance carriers is still pending and the outcome has not yet been determined.

The Parties have agreed upon four categories of injury and specified the range of compensation to be paid in each category. The Settlement Fund will provide payments to claimants from the Diocese's \$40 million advance and from monies obtained from the Diocese's claim against its insurance companies. The maximum amount of monies in the Settlement Fund will be \$120 million.

The Diocese will be reimbursed by the Fund for any amounts recovered from its insurers that exceed \$80 million. The amount of the actual payments to a particular claimant will depend on (1) the total amount of the Settlement Fund, (2) the number and nature of the total claims submitted and (3) the nature and extent of the individual claimant's injury. If any funds remain unused after all claims and expenses are paid in full, the remaining funds will be returned to the Diocese or its insurers. Under the agreement there will be no injunctive relief.

**To preserve your rights to participate in the Settlement or any further proceeding, victims must take immediate action. You must immediately complete the Confidential Census Form below and send it to Class Counsel no later than November 10, 2005.**

#### People Who May Benefit From the Settlement

You are a Class Member if:

- a priest, a member of a religious order, or anyone else assigned to or employed by the Diocese of Covington or any Diocesan parish or institution subjected you to acts of sexual abuse at any time in the past; and
- you were a minor when the abuse occurred.

You have the right to exclude yourself from the Class if (1) you were abused before 1956, (2) you were abused by someone other than a priest or member of a religious order, or (3) you were born after October 21, 1980. You may obtain an exclusion form from Class Counsel. Unless you exclude

yourself by November 20, 2005, any judgment in this case, whether favorable or not, will include you and you may enter an appearance through Counsel.

Submitting a Census Form does not prevent you from requesting exclusion or otherwise exercising the above rights. You must submit a timely Census Form to participate in the Settlement.

#### Fairness Hearing

The Court will hold a Fairness Hearing to decide whether the Settlement is fair and the amount of fees Class Counsel may receive. The Fairness Hearing will be held on January 9, 2006 at 11:00 a.m. in the Courtroom of Judge John W. Potter at the Boone County Kentucky Circuit Court in Burlington, Kentucky.

You may comment on and/or object to the Settlement. Comments and/or objections along with supporting papers must be filed on or before December 19, 2005 with the Clerk of the Court, Boone County Circuit Court, 6025 Rogers Lane, Room 141, Burlington, KY 41005-8151.

#### Confidentiality of Class Members' Identities

The Court has ordered the parties to keep the identity of Class Members confidential to the extent reasonably possible. Names of Class Members are not currently a matter of public record.

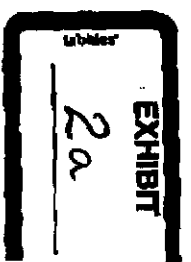

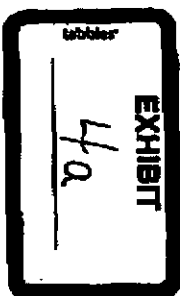

**NOTICE TO NEW CLASS MEMBERS WHO HAVE SUBMITTED CENSUS  
FORMS:**

You are being sent this Notice because you submitted a Confidential Census Form indicating that you may be a new member of the plaintiff class in the case known as *John Doe v. Roman Catholic Diocese of Covington*.

If you are a new member of the class, you have the right to exclude yourself from the class and not participate in these proceedings. If you wish to exclude yourself, you must submit the attached opt out form postmarked no later than November 20, 2005.

**A. The Lawsuit and Court Rulings**

You previously received the Notice of Proposed Class Action Settlement in this case. Ten individuals filed this class action lawsuit against the Roman Catholic Diocese of Covington, Kentucky in 2003. The plaintiffs, on behalf of a class of individuals, seek, among other things, a determination by the Court that the Diocese of Covington violated its duty to minors within the Diocese through a course of conduct that exposed said persons to sexual abuse and sexual misconduct by Diocesan priests or members of religious orders or others who were employed by or assigned to the Diocese. The class action complaint alleges that the Roman Catholic Diocese of Covington, Kentucky has engaged in an unlawful policy, pattern, or practice of concealing acts of sexual abuse by its priests and employees, and negligently supervising its priests and employees. The Diocese generally denies the legal theories advanced by the class action complaint. The Diocese further asserts that some or all of Plaintiffs' claims are barred by the statute of limitations.

On October 21, 2003, the Court ruled that this case would proceed as a class action.

On July 20, 2005, the Court preliminarily approved the Class Settlement described in the Notice of Settlement you previously received, to which you responded by submitting a Census Form.

On January 9, 2006, the Court will hold a Fairness Hearing to make a final decision as to whether the Settlement is fair. If the Court determines the settlement is fair, Settlement Funds may then be distributed to the Class Members.





**B. The Class Members (Those Who May Benefit From the Settlement)**

On October 21, 2003, the Court certified a Class defined as follows:

All persons who, while still minors at any time during the period January 1, 1956 through the present, were subjected to acts of sexual abuse and sexual misconduct by priests or members of religious orders who, at the time of such abuse or misconduct, were assigned to or employed by the Diocese of Covington.

During the period October 21, 2003 to January 31, 2004, the members of this original class were given notice of their right to opt out of the Class Action. The opt out period for members of the original class ended on January 31, 2004.

In an Order dated July 20, 2005, the Court expanded the Class to include the additional categories of persons listed below. If you fall within one of these new categories rather than within the original definition of the class described above, you are a new class member and you have the right to exclude yourself ("opt out") from the class proceeding. If you choose to exclude yourself from the class, you must complete the enclosed opt out form and have it postmarked on or before November 20, 2005.

You are a new Class Member and you are affected by this Opt Out Notice if you fall within the following definitions:

- (1) PRIOR TO 1956, WHILE YOU WERE A MINOR, YOU WERE SUBJECTED TO ACTS OF SEXUAL ABUSE OR SEXUAL MISCONDUCT BY A PRIEST, RELIGIOUS, OR OTHER PERSON WHO WAS ASSIGNED TO OR EMPLOYED BY THE DIOCESE OF COVINGTON OR ONE OF ITS PARISHES OR INSTITUTIONS;**
- (2) WHILE A MINOR, YOU WERE SUBJECTED TO ACTS OF SEXUAL ABUSE OR SEXUAL MISCONDUCT BY A LAY EMPLOYEE OF THE DIOCESE OR ONE OF ITS PARISHES OR INSTITUTIONS; or**
- (3) YOU WERE BORN AFTER OCTOBER 21, 1980 AND, WHILE A MINOR, YOU WERE SUBJECTED TO ACTS OF SEXUAL ABUSE OR SEXUAL MISCONDUCT BY A PRIEST, RELIGIOUS, OR LAY EMPLOYEE OF THE DIOCESE OR ONE OF ITS PARISHES OR INSTITUTIONS.**

The information you have provided to Class Counsel appears to place you in one or more of these categories of new class members. Therefore, you may have a right to opt out of this class action, if you so desire, as to those claims defined above. If you meet one or more of these categories, unless you exclude yourself by November 20, 2005, any settlement or judgment in this case, whether favorable or not, will include you.

**IF YOU WANT TO BE INCLUDED IN THE SETTLEMENT OF THIS CASE, YOU DO NOT NEED TO RESPOND TO THIS NOTICE.**

**C. Purpose of this Notice**

This Notice is given pursuant to Rule 23.03(2) of the Kentucky Rules of Civil Procedure. Your rights may be affected by the proceedings in this case. You will be bound by the judgment of the Court or any settlement finally approved by the Court unless you request exclusion from the Class by opting out. Members of the Class will be represented by Class Counsel and the Plaintiffs, who are Class Representatives. You may, if you desire, retain your own attorney at your own expense.

**D. Right of New Class Members to Opt Out**

If you are a new Class Member, as defined above, and if you wish to opt out of the claims described above, you must return the Opt Out Form attached to this Notice by first class United States mail postmarked on or before November 20, 2005 to:

If you meet the class definition and you DO request exclusion from this class action by opting out no later than November 20, 2005, (1) you WILL NOT SHARE IN ANY RECOVERY BY THE CLASS through settlement or judgment in this case; (2) you will not be bound by any settlement or judgment in this case; and (3) you will not be precluded from otherwise prosecuting a timely individual claim covered by the definition above through counsel of your own choice or at your own expense.

The Court's order of class certification and the Notice of Settlement you previously received are not intended to indicate and should not be construed to mean that the claims are meritorious.
