

Sauveur Dominique Tambourin

VIRGINIA CITY — The Rev. Sauveur Dominique Tambourin, 55, died Nov. 6, 1994, at Washoe Medical Center, Reno.

A native of France, he was

born Jan. 31, 1939, to Gratien and Gracieuse Gachucha Mocho Tambourin, and had lived in Virginia City for the past three months.

Tambourin was a pastor at St. Mary's in the Mountains Catholic Church. He was a Navy chaplain for 20 years, serving at the Fallon Naval Base for three years.

Tambourin was raised in Gardnerville and Fallon and attended seminary school in France.

Surviving are sister, Yvonne Berna and brother, George, both of France; and three cousins.

Recitation of the rosary is scheduled for 10:30 a.m. Thursday at the church.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Thursday at the church with burial at St. Etienne de Baicorry Cemetery, France, under the direction of Walton Funeral Home, Reno.
