REV. JOHN LORINIGHTUS

A Solemn Requiem Mass for the Rev. **John Lorinightus**, 69, will be offered at 10 A.M. today in the Church of the Nativity, 20 Madison St., Brooklyn, where he had served as assistant pastor the last five years. A husky two-fisted, onetime steam fitter and World War I Navy veteran, he tangled frequently with teen-age toughs in the Bedford-Stuyvesant section, where the church is located. But he was also known as the "Lollipop Priest," because he gave Lollipops to the neighborhood's little children. He died Sunday in St. Mary's Hospital, Brooklyn.
