

Fredonia Pastor Transferred to Buffalo Parish

The **Rev. Leo Reddy**, pastor of St. Joseph's church, Fredonia received word this morning of his transfer to St. Bridget's church, Buffalo. He will be succeeded at the Fredonia church by the **Rev. Edward Walker**, now at St. Mark's church in Buffalo.

Father **Reddy**, during his 5½ years in Fredonia, has made a host of friends not only in his own church but throughout the village and word of his transfer is received with genuine regret.

Father **Reddy**, a native of Geneva, N. Y., spent his boyhood in Dunkirk. He was educated for the priesthood at Niagara university and was ordained in 1922.

He came to Fredonia from the Immaculate Conception church at Eden where he served as pastor for over 11 years. He will assume his new duties at St. Bridget's, which is located in Fulton street and is one of the older and larger parishes of Buffalo. His successor will be installed at St. Joseph's some time next week.
