## Rev. J. Kilcullen

## Catholic chaplain, former pastor

The Rev. John M. Kilcullen, a Catholic chaplain and former pastor, died Sunday (Dec. 13, 1998) at Missouri Baptist Hospital in Town and Country of complications from pneumonia. He was 70.

Since 1996, Father Kilcullen had been chaplain of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Home at the Cardinal Carberry campus in Crestwood.

After he graduated from Kenrick Seminary and was ordained in 1955, he served as associate pastor at Holy Innocents, Our Lady of Presentation and St. Jude Catholic churches. He was pastor of All Souls Catholic Church in Overland from 1972 to 1983 and at St. Mary Magdalen in Brentwood from 1983

to 1996. He was also a former spiritual director of the Archdiocesan Holy Name Society.
