

Brother John SCHRECK OFM



CHRECK Brother John, OFM, a Franciscan friar of the Province of St. John the Baptist, died May 5 at Mercy Hospital Mt. Airy. He was 60. A native of Emporia, Kansas, he resided at St. Clare Friary in Cincinnati. The son of Sylvester and Evelyn (McGlinn) Schreck, both whom preceded him in death, he attended Sacred Heart School in Emporia and graduated from St. Francis Seminary, the friars' high school in Cincinnati. He continued his studies at Duns Scotus College in Southfield, Mich., earning a B.A.in philosophy, and professed his final vows as a friar in 1966. His talents benefited every community in which he served. He was an auto mechanic at the friars' formation houses from 1967-1992 and spent the next 11 years in Cincinnati as a skilled maintenanc e man and a master woodworker. In 2003 he joined the computer technology staff of St. Anthony Messenger Press. He is survived by a brother, James E. Schreck, of Emporia, Kansas, and a sister-in-law, Christy, and his brother frars of St. John the Baptist Province. Visitation is 5-7 P.M. Monday, May 9, at St. Clement Church in St. Bernard, Ohio, followed by a Mass of Christian Burial at 7 P.M. Interment in at 11 A.M.
