Concelebrated Mass of the Resurrection for the Rev. Harry A. Brockman, SJ, will be 3 p. m. Monday at St. Patrick's Church, Cleveland. Burial will be Cleveland.

Father Brockman, a Cincinnati native, died Wednesday in the Colombiere College infirmary, Clark-

ston. Mich. He was 91.

He was a brother of the late Rev. Hubert S. Brockman, SJ, president of Xavier University from 1922 to 1930. Among many surviving nieces and nephews is the Rev. William P. LeSaint, SJ, a research professor in theology at Xavier.

Father Brockman joined Jesuits

in 1900: He was the oldest living Jesuit in the Chicago province, which includes Cincinnati. He was ordained in 1915 in St. Louis, and received a bachelor of arts degree from Xavier in 1901.

Father Brockman was a teacher and counselor at St. Ignatious High School, Cleveland, for 31 years until 1970 when he retired and moved to Clarkston. A room in the St. Ignatious library has been dedicated in his honor.

A wake will be held at the high school today.
