Langer had served as pastor for St. Joseph's Catholic Church,

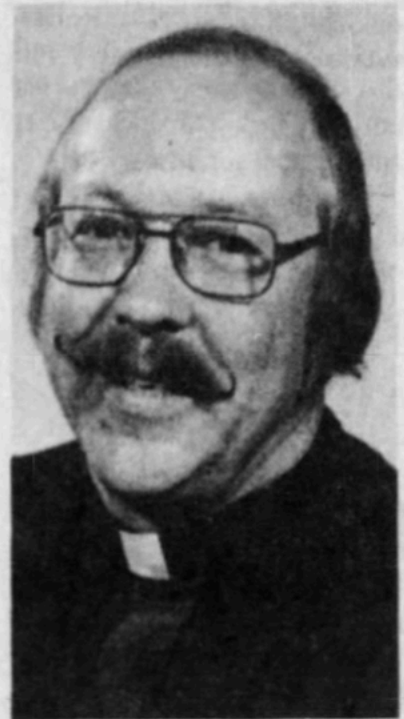
Rock Falls. He is currently the pastor of Holy Family Catholic Church, Poniatoski.
