

## Msgr. Cyr dead at 65 in Biddeford

BIDDEFORD — The Rev. Msgr. Armand E. Cyr, 65, died Sunday, May 28, at a nursing home here after a long illness. In 1972, he had resigned as pastor of Holy Rosary Parish, Caribou, because of ill health. Msgr. Cyr was born in Lille, Feb. 13, 1913, the son of Pierre A. and Laura (Dumont) Cyr. He was a graduate of Assumption Preparatory School and of Assumption College, Worcester, Mass. He studied at Oxford University, England, and made his clerical studies at the Gregorian Pontifical University, Rome, Italy, where he received a Licentiate in Sacred Theology.

A Mass of the Resurrection will be held Thursday, June 1, at 4:30 p.m. in St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church with Bishop Edward O'Leary officiating.

An service for the Faithful Departed will be held Wednesday at 7 p.m. at the church.
